2026 - 2027 Electronic Device Consequences

Consequences for violating the electronic device policy grades PK-8:

- First offense: Student conference, parent/guardian contact, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick-up the electronic device.
- Second offense: Student Timeout, parent/guardian contact, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick-up the electronic device.
- Third offense: 1-3 days ISS, parent/guardian conference, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick up the electronic device, electronic devices banned from campus for 30 days.
- Fourth offense: 3-5 days ISS, parent/guardian contact, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick up the electronic device, electronic devices banned from campus for 60 days.
- Fifth offense and each offense after: 1-3 days OSS, parent/guardian contact, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick up the electronic device, electronic devices banned from campus for the remainder of the school year. **Students in grades 7 and 8 may face suspension pending tribunal for repeated violations of the schools electronic device policy, parents/guardians must come to the school to pick-up the electronic device.**

Consequences for violating the electronic device policy grades 9-12:

- First offense: parent/guardian contact, electronic devices will be returned to the student at the end of the school day.
- Second offense: 1 day ISS, parent/guardian contact, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick-up the electronic device, electronic devices banned from campus for 30 days.
- Third offense: 3 days ISS, parent contact, parent/guardian conference, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick-up the electronic device, Electronic devices banned from campus for 60 days.
- Fourth Offense: 3 days OSS, parent/guardian contact, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick-up the electronic device, electronic devices banned from campus for the remainder of the school year.
- Fifth offense: Suspension pending tribunal for repeated violations of the schools electronic device policy, parent/guardian must come to the school to pick-up the electronic device.
