<u>Abrasions and Lacerations</u>	Cleanse with antibacterial soap and/or saline solution. May apply triple antibiotic ointment, steri-strips and bandage as indicated.
<u>Allergic Reaction - Severe</u>	Contact EMS immediately. Call parent. Give Epi-pen per protocol.
<u>Allergic Reaction — Local</u>	Oral Diphenhydramine or Cetirizine. Dosage as specified by age/weight per label directions, for local symptomatic reactions (hives, welts, generalized itching). Call parent if indicated.
<u>Asthmatic Episode</u>	Administer prescribed inhaler or nebulizer with parent provided medications. If symptoms persist, or no inhaler is available, call parent.
<u>Conjunctivitis or pinkeye</u>	May rinse eyes with eyewash solutions. Cool compresses and refer to physician if indicated.
<u>Dental Pain</u>	Oragel, Orabase or generic equivalent applied per label directions.
<u>Earache</u>	Apply warm compress. Contact parent and refer to physician if it persists or is ineffective.

<u>Eye Irritation</u>	Irrigate with normal saline, tap water, Tears Natural or generic equivalent. Contact parent as indicated.
<u>Fever</u>	For an oral temperature of 100.4 F or above, call parent to pick up child. While waiting continue to monitor temperature, if temperature is 101 > then Acetaminophen, or generic equivalent, *may be given according to weight directions on label.
<u>Headache</u>	Rest and hydration.
<u>Head Injury</u>	Concussion assessment done, parent to be notified, if parent chooses to pick student up, nurse will give concussion education sheet.
<u>Insect Stings/Contact Dermatitis</u>	Remove stinger. Apply hydrocortisone cream, 911 spray, 1% baking soda plaster and/or ice pack. Observe for severe reaction. Contact parent as indicated.
<u>Menstrual Cramps</u>	Rest and/or heating pad.
<u>Minor Thermal Burns</u>	Apply a cool pack to stop the burning process. Cover area with sterile non-stick bandage or "Second Skin." Contact parent. For chemical, electrical and 2 nd or 3 rd degree burns, physician referral or EMS as indicated.
<u>Nausea, Indigestion</u>	Crackers, clear liquids, peppermint (for student 8 years old and up), Tums (one tablet for children 8 — 12, two tablets for children >12. Limit one dose per day), and rest.

<u>Opioid Overdose</u>	Administer emergency dose of nasal naloxone. Contact 911. Monitor vital signs until EMS arrives.
<u>Pediculosis</u>	Must send home if live bugs seen, call parent to pick up. May stay if only eggs and no live bugs seen, call parent to discuss options.
<u>Pulse Oximeter Guidelines</u>	Accepted guidelines for using finger pulse oximeter as an assessment tool: Notify parents: below 90 and below Contact EMS: 85 and below
<u>Scabies</u>	Exclude from school until confirmed and treated.
<u>Sore Throat/Cough</u>	Saline gargles, or for students above 8 years old cough or throat lozenges (limit one cough drop per 4 hours).
<u>Sunburn</u>	Aloe Vera (OTC) topically for relief, 911 spray.
<u>Sprains/Strains</u>	Elevate, apply ice and ace as indicated. Notify parents, if physician referral is needed. For students in a secondary athletic program, contact athletic trainer to evaluate.
