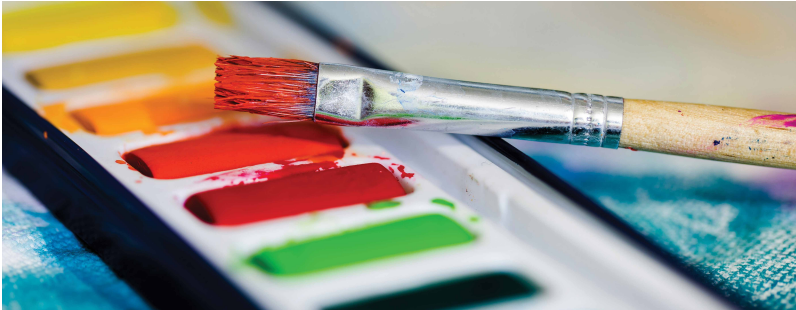

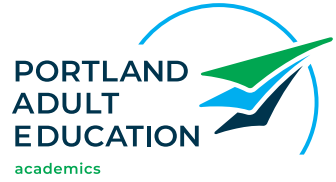

PAE Workforce Training

New Mainers Resource Center

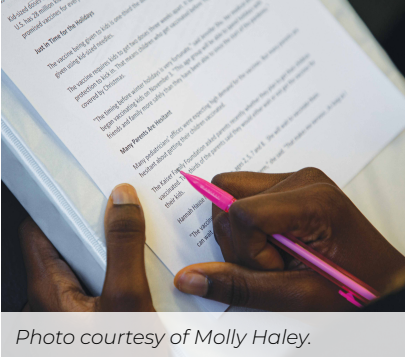

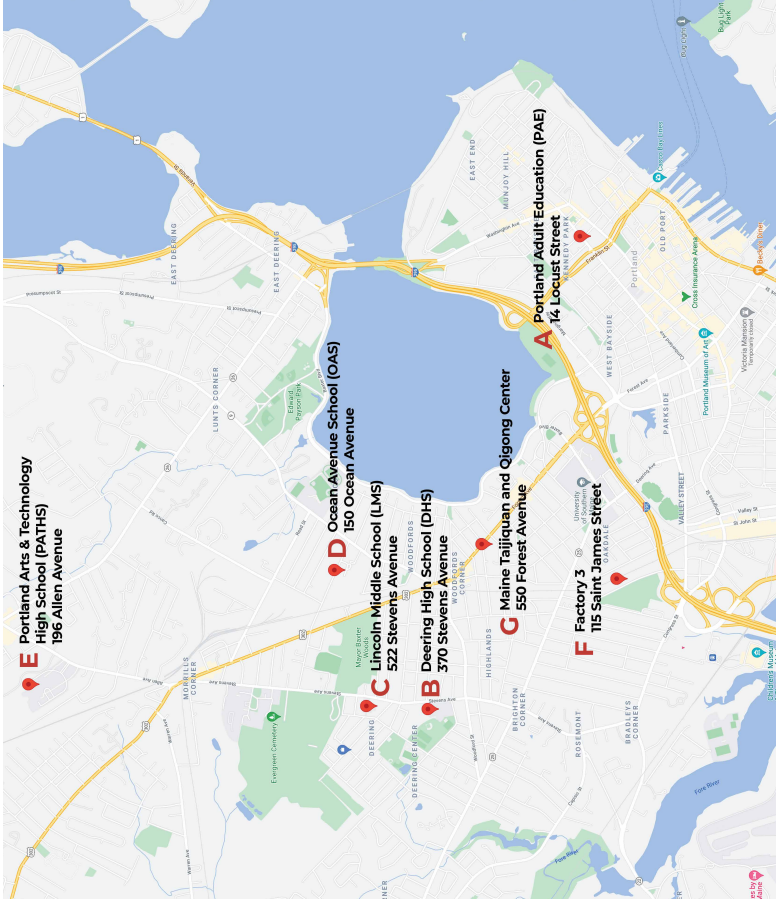
