Unless otherwise noted, high school course exams consist of two separate tests (one for each semester). A score of 80% or higher on both semester tests is required to earn credit for the entire class.

Counselors must check that all prerequisite courses are completed before verifying a student's registration for a CBE test.

Counselors should consider future scheduling implications when advising students on registering for CBE tests.
