How To Become a Substitute:

Complete the online application. Certified substitutes are for substitute teaching and classified substitutes are for all other substitute positions. To view all substitute openings, please visit: <https://www.applitrack.com/raytownschools/onlineapp/> and select "Classified/Certified substitute." You can also scan the QR code to the right.

Raytown Quality Schools is offering to cover the cost of background checks for substitutes that apply. Once you apply, you will be invited to come into the Human Resources office to meet with the HR Coordinator for substitutes. At this meeting you will pre-register online for fingerprinting through the State Highway Patrol's Missouri Automated Criminal History Site, and you will register online through the Department of Health & Senior Services.



Requirements to be a Substitute Teacher:

You must have either a current Missouri teaching certificate, have a current substitute certificate, or complete DESE's 20 hour substitute teacher training. A Content Substitute certificate may now be granted to an individual who has successfully completed a minimum of 20 hours of department-approved substitute teacher training. The 20 hours of online training to be a substitute teacher is available through Frontline Education, Kelly Education, as well as several Missouri colleges and universities. The Raytown Schools Wellness Center’s mission is to provide outstanding educational opportunities for students, attractive benefits to employees, and support every member of the school community in reaching their wellness goals in a caring, hospitable environment through a highly-trained, friendly, professional staff.

Eligibility

Facility users must live or work within district boundaries. A valid driver’s license, government-issued ID card, work ID badge, or a pay stub from an employer is required for community member registration. Facility use is free for all district employees, their spouses, and their dependents under the age of 18.

Age Restrictions

Children age 13 and up can use the exercise floor. Children ages 13-15 must be accompanied by a legal guardian or sibling age 16 or older. A child under the age of 13 can walk the track with a legal guardian.

Pool Usage

A lap pool and zero entrance warm pool are available to all facility users. Those under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a legal guardian or a sibling age 16 or older.

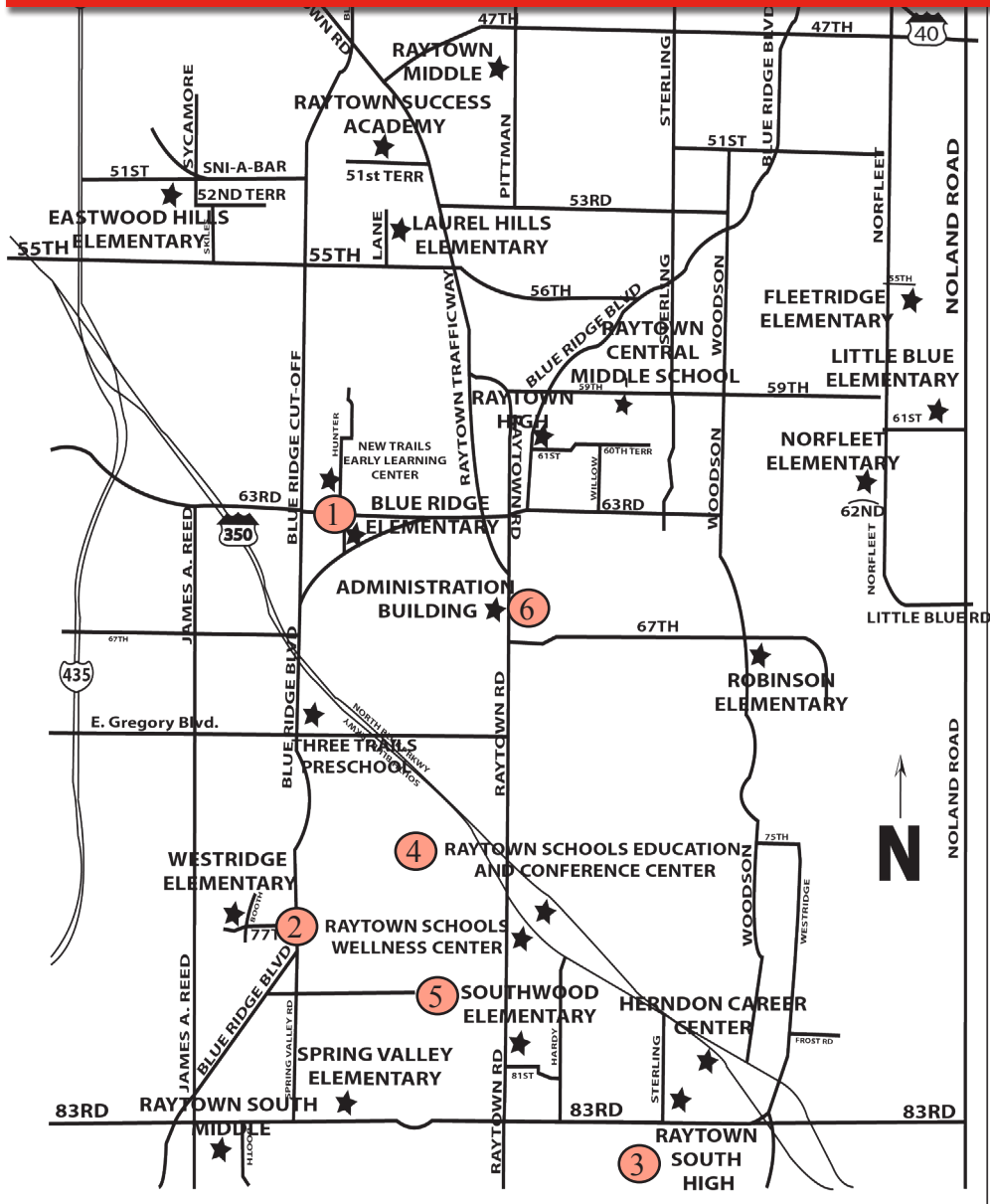
