WHAT IS A COMPLETER?

A completer is a student who has earned all of the required units (3 or 4 classes depending on the program) in a state-recognized CTE program.

A student is considered "career-ready" if the student becomes a completer **and** earns a national or state recognized industry credential in that program area.

Example:

Health Science 2

NEW TIERED CREDENTIAL REQUIREMENT

(BEGINNING THE 2025/2026 SCHOOL YEAR)

The tiered credential system will be in effect for the 9GR=25 cohort
(current 10th graders).

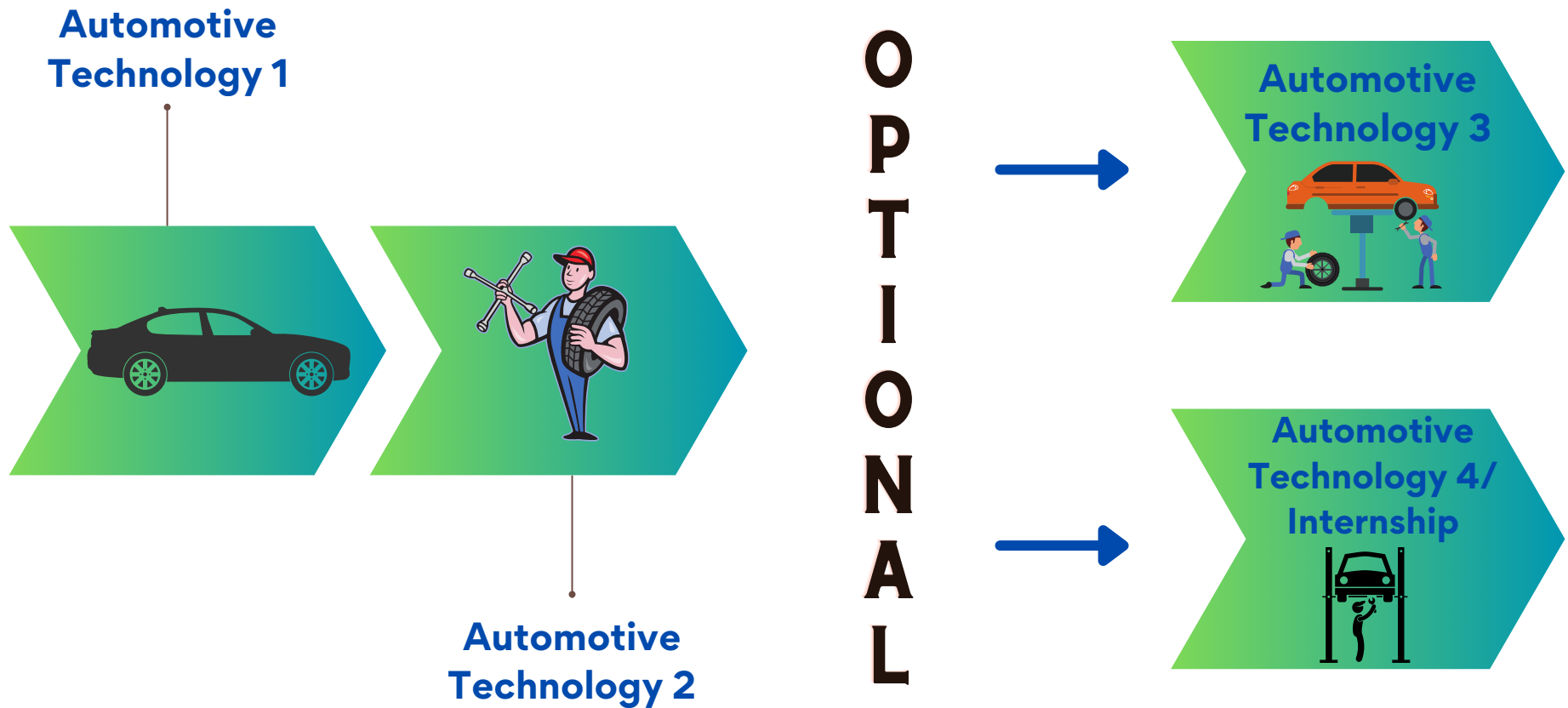
Students must be a CTE completer and earn a minimum of 3 points by:

- One Tier 3 credential aligned with the career cluster.
- A combo of one Tier 2 and one Tier 1 credential within the same career cluster.
- A universal credential (OSHA, Microburst, etc.) paired with a Tier 2 or higher credential within the student's career cluster.

**** Three Tier 1 credentials will not work.**

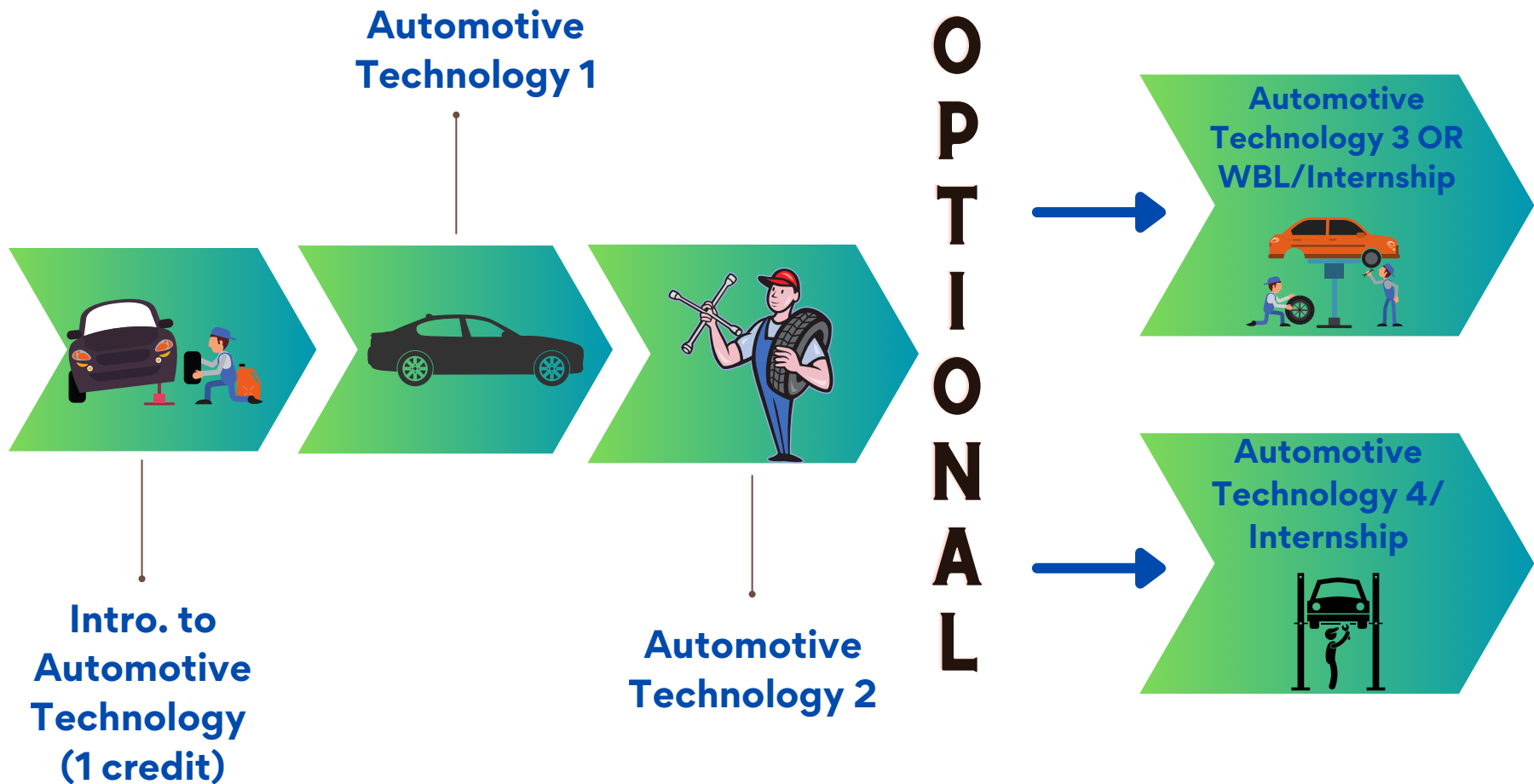
****9GR=23 (current Seniors) and 9GR=24 (current Juniors) will remain on the old career readiness system.**
