Required Materials for All Classes

- Charged Chromebook
- Chromebook Charger
- Earbuds/headphones
- 2-3 packs of pencils (replace often)
- Erasers
- Pencil Sharpener
- Blue and/or Black Pens
- Colored Pencils
- Multi-Colored Highlighter Pack
- Pencil Case

Math:

- You will need a place to organize your handouts, classwork, and notes. Please choose one of the following that works best for you:
 - Graphing Composition Notebook (2) **OR**
 - Spiral Bound Graphing Notebook (2) **AND**
 - Binder or Folder
- Suggested Calculator - TI 84 CE (this is the calculator that will be used from here on out at PGSD)

ELA:

- 2 Single Subject Notebooks or Composition Notebooks
- Independent Reading Book (Grade-level chapter book)
- You will need a place to organize your handouts, classwork, and notes. Please choose one of the following that works best for you:
 - 2 folders **OR**
 - 1.5-inch binder with loose-leaf paper **OR**
 - Expandable Portfolio

Social Studies:

- A pair of headphones to leave in the classroom
- Highlighters will be used often during class
- Please choose one of the following that works best for you:
 - 3 subject spiral notebook for writing prompts and taking class notes **OR**
 - 2 folders for organizing handouts and classwork

Science:

- Graphing composition notebook
 - 2 pocket folder
