The workshop emphasizes integrating high-leverage instructional strategies, Universal Design for Learning (UDL), and Specially Designed Instruction (SDI) into co-taught lessons. By the end of the day, participants will leave with actionable tools and strategies to implement and sustain inclusive, high-impact learning environments that meet their students' needs.
