SCHOOL BREAKFAST AND LUNCH PROGRAMS

Our cafeteria is a pleasant and attractive part of our school. It plays a very important part in meeting the nutritional needs of our students. The staff of our cafeteria consists of highly trained personnel, who provide well-balanced meals.

Frasch Elementary will be participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) program for the current school year. This is GREAT news for you and our students because there will be no charge for a healthy breakfast and lunch. No further action is required of you. Free/reduced lunch forms do not have to be completed.

Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay or submit a meal application.

BREAKFAST

Breakfast is served every day from **7:15 a.m. - 7:40 a.m.** Students must arrive on time and go straight to the cafeteria if they choose to eat breakfast. Remind your child to go to the cafeteria before going to class if they want breakfast. PreK students will go to breakfast as a class at the beginning of their day.

LUNCH

Students will go to lunch as a class following their daily schedule. Students may choose to eat in the cafeteria or bring lunch from home. Students bringing their lunches from home are required to eat along with students having cafeteria lunches.

No student will be allowed to heat up their lunch. Thermos bottles are allowed.
