

2026 VACCINE CLINIC INFORMATION



Flu

Seasonal vaccine recommended for most people. Employees and dependents ages 5 and up.



MMR

Typically a once in a lifetime measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine. If you're unsure if you've had this vaccine or need proof of vaccination, a duplicate dose does not cause harm.



Shingles

Two doses recommended for those ages 50 and up to protect against shingles. Is recommended if you've had a dose of an older shingles vaccine.



COVID

Newest formulation designed to protect against circulating variants. For employees and dependents whom this season's dose is recommended.



TDAP

Recommended every 10 years to protect against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (whooping cough). If you're unsure of your last dose, a duplicate dose does not cause harm.



Pneumonia

A once in a lifetime pneumonia vaccine for those ages 65+ and those at risk for severe pneumonia. A dose may be recommended if you've had a dose of an older pneumonia vaccine.



Eligible Insurance Plans

- BCBSAZ, Federal BCBS and other out of area BCBS.
- United Health Care/ Kairos
- Meritain/ASBAIT
- Tricare
- Medicare and Medicare alternative insurance plans, such as Humana, Secure Horizons, United Advantage, Sterling, or Railroad Medicare. Medicare will NOT pay for Shingles, TDAP or MMR vaccines during this clinic.
- AHCCCS plans cannot be accepted at this clinic.
- No insurance? Cash payments will be accepted for vaccines.



Day of Clinic

Our staff will check in at the front office and follow all check-in/ security procedures required.

The following must be provided by your sites:

- A semi-private area. Please do not plan for clinics to be set in nurse's offices as we don't want our staff or those receiving vaccines to be exposed to those who are unwell. Please select an area which is not heavily trafficked by students ex: gymnasium, cafeteria during meals, ect.
- One large table or two small tables.
- Two chairs
- A trashcan

What to bring:

- Employees may come with their consent forms completed or may fill them out at the clinic. Consent forms and pens will be provided.
- Please bring your insurance card to your vaccine clinic.

We want as many people as possible to have access to this benefit. Please plan to come during passing periods or work together to cover classes. Typically, receiving vaccinations at our clinics takes less than 15 minutes.
