One of the most important forms of communication is the automated communication system called **ParentSquare**. You are automatically enrolled in the automated system through the student registration process. This system is used for upcoming events, important messages, as well as attendance.

When a student is not in attendance and a parent has not notified the school of the absence, Mrs. Grinolds will call to verify the student's absence. If she is unable to reach a parent or guardian, expect to receive a notification from ParentSquare.
