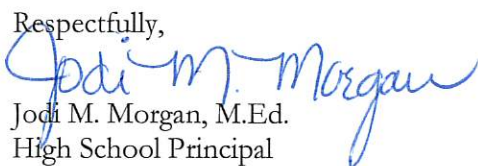
- Attends school daily and arrives on time (*Review the attendance policy with your student*)

Academic Support at Thompson Falls High School

Please do not hesitate to reach out to your child's teachers, Mr. Christensen (School Counselor), or Ms. Kenney (GEAR UP Coordinator) whenever assistance is needed. We believe that seeking help is a sign of strength, and we are committed to helping your student reach their full potential.

Remember, your child's education is a partnership between your child, your child's educators, and your child's support network. The following lists the academic support resources available at TFHS:

- Mr. Christensen does grade checks on Monday mornings and reaches out to students who aren't passing classes to connect them to help.
- Accommodated Academic Support -- Mrs. Farlan is located in Room 16. She is available during the day to help students with academic needs and accommodation plans.
- After school Study Table located in the HS Library: Mondays – Thursdays 3:15 – 4:00 pm. Students are welcome to work in the library during this time with peers/study groups and/or ask for additional help from Mrs. Lundberg.
- Academic Support - Mrs. Rueda is available in the HS Library for academic support during 6th & 7th periods.
- Reading for Success – Mrs. Ferris teaches a supplemental reading class for all students who need to improve their reading skills. The course is offered during 5th period.
- Math Lab and Lit Lab classes are offered for students to enroll in during 7th period. Mrs. Lyght will provide English support for students while Mr. Mamaril will provide math support for students.
- High School teachers are available before and after school for students who would like help. Some teachers are available during lunch as well. All high school teachers have a prep period during the school day when students can stop by for extra support.

Encourage your child to stay focused, stay motivated, and never be afraid to ask for help when needed. We are proud to have you and your child as part of our educational family and look forward to witnessing their achievement.
