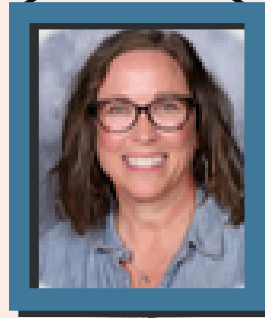

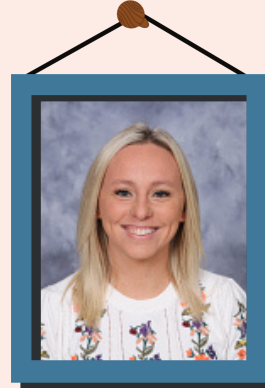


Don't Forget!!

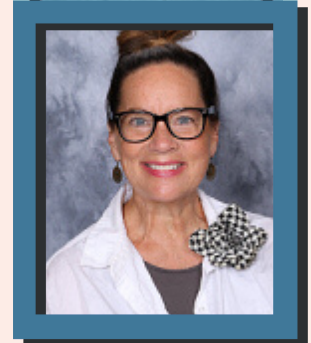
