Attendance Matters!

Every school day counts. Research consistently shows that students who attend school regularly are more successful academically and socially. We ask for your partnership in making attendance a priority this year. **Unless your child is ill or experiencing an emergency, please make every effort to have them at school each day and on time.**

If your child is absent, please complete the **Absence Request Form**, available on our website, in the Parent Hub, and at the top of our Class Dojo page. If you are unable to complete the form, you may also send a handwritten note, email, or Class Dojo message to your child's teacher.

Together, we can help every child achieve their full potential, but we need them in school in order to accomplish this.

A Few Important Reminders...

- **School Supplies:** Supply lists are available on our website and on the Parent HUB. If you need assistance obtaining supplies, please contact your child's teacher or our main office—we're here to help!
- **School Hours:** Doors open at **8:40 AM** Students are marked tardy at **8:55 AM** Dismissal begins at **3:25 PM**.
- **Car Line:** Student safety is our top priority. Please remember that all car riders must be dropped off and picked up at the **rear entrance** of the school. The front entrance is reserved for buses and students who walk from home. **Students should never be dropped off along Duncan Road.** Carline numbers will be available at our Community Resource Fair on August 20. Please bring your ID. Please review our arrival and dismissal procedures from the Parent HUB and share this information with anyone transporting your child. Thank you!
- **Bus Transportation:** Families should receive bus information from BSD Transportation before the start of school. Questions regarding transportation should be directed to BSD Transportation at **302-762-7181**.
- **Breakfast & Lunch:** Breakfast and lunch are available **free of charge** to all MPE students. Families may set up an account for snack purchases on the [BSD Nutrition Services website](#).
- **Communication:** Strong communication between home and school is essential to student success. **ClassDojo** remains our primary communication platform, and we ask every family to join. Information will be shared during Take a Peek Night on August 20.
- **Kindergarten Families:** Kindergarten parents are welcome to walk their child to class during the **first two days of school**. Beginning **Monday, August 31**, all students will transition to entering school independently with staff support. We will have **Kindergarten Orientation on August 26**. Our teachers will mail parents their specific time to come in.
- **Back to School Night:** Please save the date for our **Back to School Night on Thursday, September 10**.

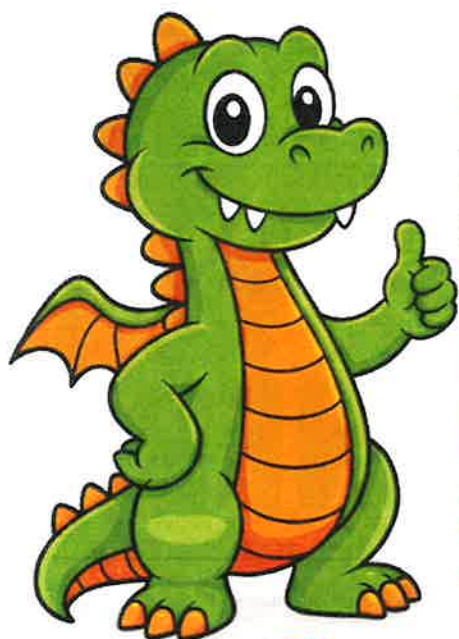

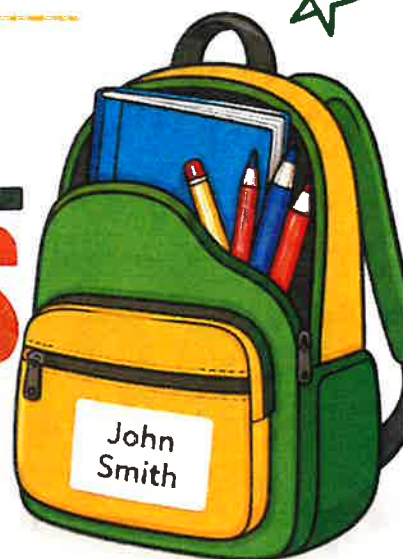

AT SCHOOL



Please label everything from home with your child's first and last name.

HELP US HELP YOUR CHILD!

Labeling your child's belongings helps us return lost items quickly and keeps our school day running smoothly. Thank you for your partnership in keeping our Dragons organized and ready to learn!



CELL PHONES / COMMUNICATION DEVICES

- Students who have a cell phone or other communication device at school are to keep it off and away at all times during the day.
- Cell phones must be in a clothing pocket or given to the teacher to lock up during the school day.
- Cell phones are not to be left unattended in a student's book bag, desk, or cubby, since these locations are not secured.
- The unauthorized use of electronic devices such as but not limited to cell phones, apple watches, audio players, video games, communication devices, etc. that results in a disruption to the educational process or jeopardizes the health, safety or welfare of students or staff may result in the **immediate confiscation of the electronic device.**



MONEY

- Students are not to bring "extra" amounts of money to school.
- Snack money should be kept with the student or preferably loaded onto their nutrition account.
- Any money that is to be collected for field trips, etc. should be given directly to the teacher in a sealed envelope with the student's name clearly labeled.
- Parents are asked to be aware of the amount and the purpose of any money their child brings to school.

★ DRESS RIGHT. LEARN BRIGHT! ★

1. COVER UP



All shirts must cover shoulders, chest, and midriff.

2. AT THE WAIST



Pants and shorts are to be worn at the waist. (*Pajamas are prohibited*)

3. APPROPRIATE LENGTH



The length of skirts, shorts, shorts, and dresses must be at least **mid-thigh** in length.

4. COATS & JACKETS



Heavy, bulky jackets or overcoats should be placed in lockers.

5. FOOTWEAR



- ✓ Footwear must be worn at all times.
- ✗ Flip flops and slides are not permitted.
- ✓ Rubber-soled shoes are required for Physical Education class.

6. APPROPRIATE CLOTHING



Clothing with inappropriate, suggestive, or derogatory pictures or phrases may not be worn.

7. NO UNDERGARMENTS SHOWING



Clothing designed to be worn as undergarments may not be visible.

8. NO HEADWEAR



No headwear is to be worn in the building during the school day. This includes, but is not limited to hats, bandanas, scarves, earmuffs, sunglasses, or any other head covering, including hoods.

9. NO FRAYED OR HOLED CLOTHING



Clothing with frayed edges or visible holes is not permitted unless there is a layer of clothing under the frayed item.

10. SAFE JEWELRY & ACCESSORIES



Students wearing jewelry or accessories that may be considered unsafe or inappropriate to the learning environment may be subject to review by the administration.

Wear at your own risk.
MPE is not responsible for items that are lost or stolen.

11. NO DISTRACTIONS



Any other garments or accessories that would be a distraction to the orderly educational process are prohibited.
