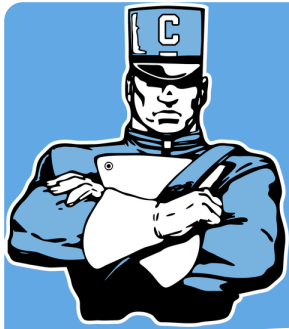
I will be working with attendance this year. Good attendance is important for academic and social success. If your child cannot attend school, please make sure to report the absence.



Discipline/policy changes



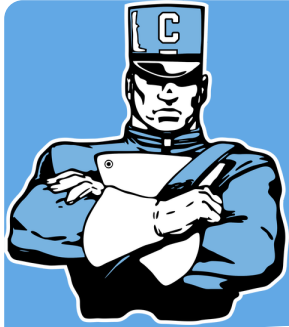
- **Students must use lockers, no backpacks in classrooms**

Message from Mr. DuBois What Can I Do For You?

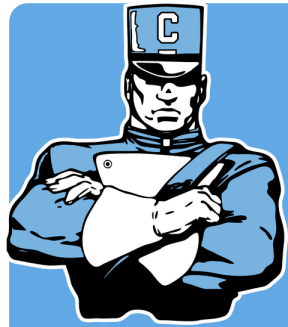


I am an Indiana licensed school counselor

-Overall Success - academics, attendance, behavior, social security benefits, insurance documents, access to needs, post-Cascade planning

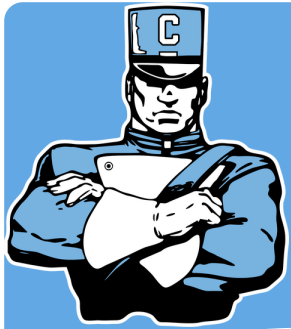


Message from Mr. DuBois

What Can I Do For You?



- Schedule/Course selection
 - diploma seals, Area 31, dual credits, testing
- Testing- SAT, ACT, PSAT, ILEARN, ASVAB
 - (All Grade 9 take PSAT)
- Diploma Seals/Transcript/Graduation - no shortcuts
 - erase the phrase “can I just...”
- Prepare to exit - must have a plan
 - career/major, scholarships, internships, applications



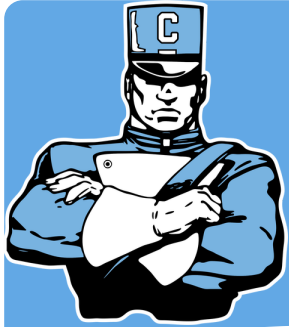

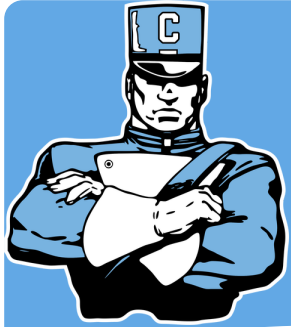

How is HS different from MS?



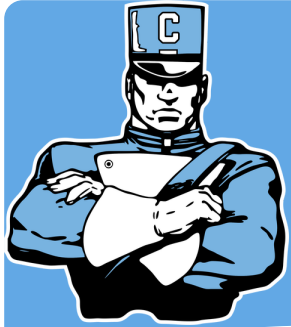
- All classes are important- Core, Pathways, Elective
- Graduation Requirements - failure of most any class would need to be repeated
- Indiana Diploma with Honors Seal or Honors Plus Seal in Enrollment, Employment, or Enlistment/Service --a fluid decision, set goals now
- Typically the last few days of a semester, students have final exams/presentations/etc–Need to be in attendance



Diploma Requirements



- **Shoot for the Stars!—**
 - **Honors Plus Seal**
 - **Enrollment**
 - **Employment**
 - **Enlistment/Service**
- **Know that watching diploma requirements is my job**
 - **Please remember the Requirements have changed**
- **If you have a classroom question, ask your child then contact the teacher...don't be afraid to ask questions**
- **ASK ME! email or phone**

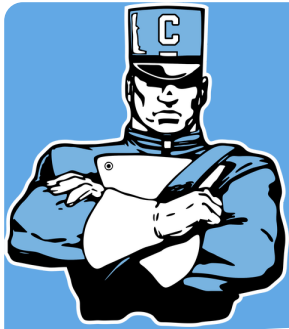


It is all About the Transcript



Transcripts stay with your child forever!!!

- **The transcript is what employers/apprenticeships/colleges see**
- **Proof of....enrollment, GPA, address....**
- **Must include all high school grades/credits but can grade replace the same class**

Classes of 2029 and Beyond Grade Point Average (GPA) and Latin Honors:

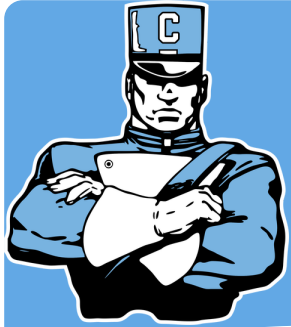
Beginning with the Class of 2029, Cascade High School will utilize the Latin Honors system as the primary method for recognizing academic achievement at graduation. Academic honors will be determined using a student's cumulative weighted GPA at the conclusion of their senior year. This approach allows the school to celebrate academic excellence across a wider group of students, supports and encourages rigorous coursework, and provides a consistent and meaningful framework for recognizing achievement at graduation.

Students will be recognized according to the following distinctions:

Summa Cum Laude – 4.25 and above

Magna Cum Laude – 4.00–4.24

Cum Laude – 3.75–3.99

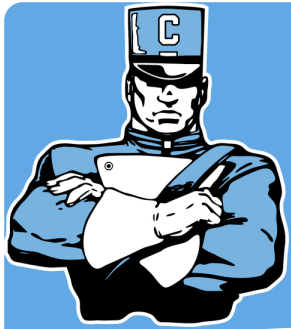

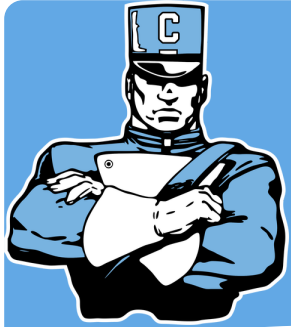

Stay Involved-Parents



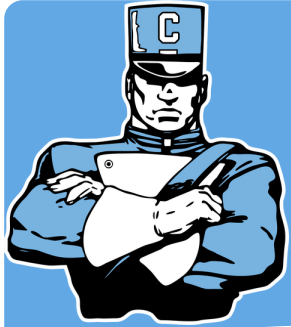

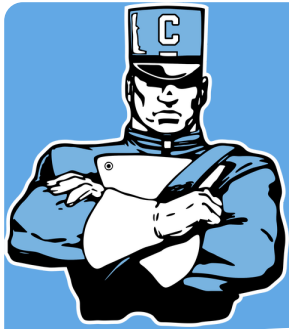
Hot Topics for Freshmen

Cascade does not offer a Drivers Education Course - Straight Paths (Greencastle) or Coaches (Avon)

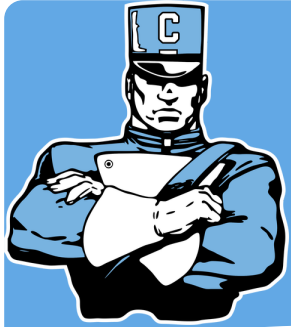


Your student's class schedule
