Texas Core Curriculum Course Offerings 2026-2027*

The Dallas Independent School District (Dallas ISD) has an Interlocal Agreement with the Dallas College, which includes a course equivalency crosswalk. The crosswalk provides a framework for outlining dual credit courses that are aligned with the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's Texas Core Curriculum (TCC). The TCC is a 42 Semester Credit Hour (SCH) core curriculum for all undergraduate students in Texas. The purpose of the core curriculum is to ensure that Texas undergraduate students enrolled in public institutions of higher education will develop the essential knowledge and skills they need in order to be successful in college, in a career, in their communities, and in life. There are nine Foundational Component Areas (FCA), including one Component Area Option (CAO). The CAO may provide options for students to choose additional courses from the other FCA. Below you will find Dallas ISD's course offerings designed to assist students in completing the TCC through coursework completed at any of the seven Dallas College campuses. ***Not all courses are offered at all campuses. This is a sample of what courses may be available. Speak to the dual credit counselor or coordinator for more details.**
