

E-MOTORCYCLES NOT ALLOWED ON CAMPUS



E-motorcycles are motor vehicles under Texas law. Because students travel to campus on public roadways, **they are not permitted on Eanes ISD campuses unless the requirements below are met.**

TEXAS LAW REQUIREMENTS



CLASS M ENDORSEMENT

Operator must have a valid Texas driver's license with a Class M motorcycle endorsement.



INSURANCE

Must carry liability insurance.



REGISTERED & LICENSED

Vehicle must be registered and display a valid license plate.



HELMET REQUIRED

Helmet use is required by law.



WHERE IT CAN BE OPERATED

Prohibited on sidewalks. Legal for public roadways (when registered) or private property and race tracks.



Under Texas Transportation Code §502.001, **e-motorcycles must be registered to operate on public roadways.**

ENFORCEMENT PLAN

EDUCATE

We will educate students and parents about the legal requirements and safety concerns.

WARNING

For a first offense, an officer will contact the parent or guardian to explain the law and issue a warning.

ENFORCEMENT

Continued violations may result in:

- A citation to the parent/guardian for allowing an unlicensed driver to operate a motor vehicle.
- Seizure of the e-motorcycle when authorized by law.
