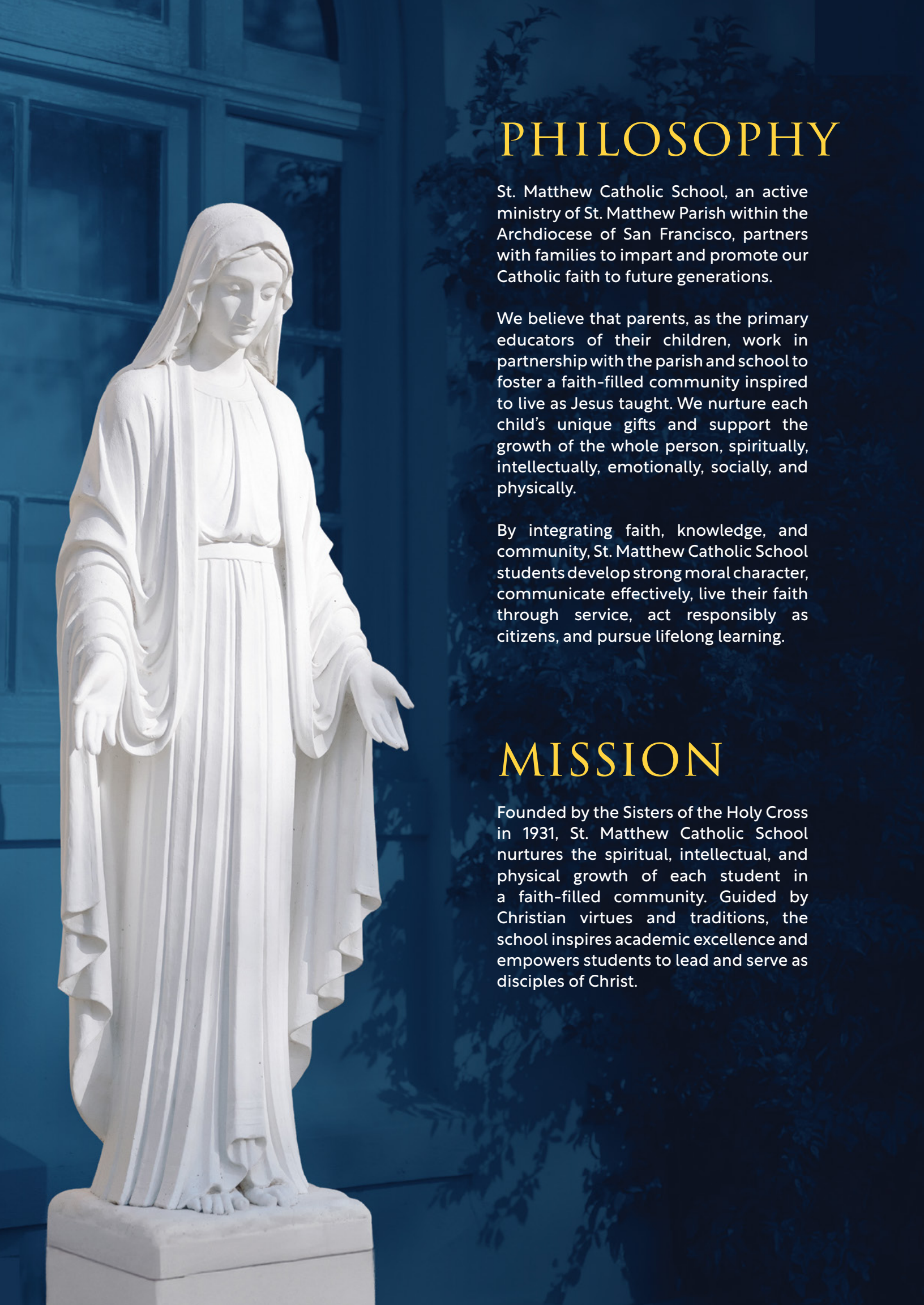




PHILOSOPHY
