ParentSquare

- One stop shop for communication and updates with schools in FCPS
- This is a two-way platform that will allow school wide, group, and teacher/parent communication
- Choose how you receive messages (email or text, instant vs. digest)
- School calendar of events
- Translates to 100+ languages
- App is available for Apple and Android

Parent Communication

- Beaumont Newsletter through ParentSquare
 - Sent out each week on Friday afternoon
 - Email in Infinite Campus
 - ParentSquare allows for language translation
- Parent Portal
 - See up to the minute grades, attendance, assessments, etc. for your student
 - Go to www.fcps.net and click on Campus Parent icon. You will then click on Log in to Campus Parent and follow directions to set up an account.

Parent Communication (Cont.)

- eOS

This is an online behavior management system where we track student's progress

Parent Communication (Cont.)

- Canvas
 - Learning Management System used by middle and high schools in Fayette County
 - You can download Canvas Parent app and pair your account to your student to see assignments, messages, etc.
 - To pair your account, have your student log into their account, go to Settings, and click on Pair with Observer to get a code for the app.

eOS

- This is an online behavior management system that we use to track student progress for 3 school wide expectations:
 - *Prepared for Class, Respectful, and Meets Class Expectations*
- Students can gain up to 3 points per class for meeting all expectations
- Students must have 90% of their points in order to attend school wide incentives (ex. School dances)
- Students can also earn eBucks to spend with team incentives for doing positive things throughout the day.
- If a student has an unexcused absence, then they lose all the points for that day. Students must turn in a note within 3 school days to get an excused absence.

Volunteering at Beaumont

- We love to have parents come in and work with students and/or teams during school activities and field trips.
- In order to be a volunteer, you must have an approved background check done by FCPS.
- Go to www.fcps.net/volunteer, then complete the Application and interest/availability survey to start the process.

Teams at Beaumont

- We have 2 teams in 6th and 7th grade for the 2026-2027 school year:
 - *6th Grade: Pegasus and Stampede*
 - *7th Grade: Champions and Thoroughbreds*
 - *8th Grade: The 8th Grade Team*
- Creates 5 small schools within a big school
- Teams are organized in pods so that teams of the same grade level are not near one another. We also have a staggered bell schedule so that only one grade level is in the halls at any given time.
- Each team works with the same group of students
 - *Allows for consistency for students*
 - *Allows the team of teachers to work closely together to help all our students be successful*

Arrival at School

- School hours each day are 9:05-3:55
- Buses use the main parking lot to drop off students from 8:35-9:05
- Parents can drop their students off in the car circle
- Doors open at 8:35
- 6th Graders report to the cafeteria if they arrive before 8:45 or if they would like to have breakfast
- 6th Graders are dismissed to their 1st period class at 8:45



Dismissal from School

- IF YOUR CHILD IS RIDING A BUS, PLEASE MAKE SURE THEY KNOW THEIR BUS NUMBER BEFORE THEY COME ON AUGUST 12!!!!
- This information will be available on the district website. Click on School Buses and then School Bus Portal.
- You need to choose Yes/No in Campus Parent for transportation to have a bus stop assigned to your student.
- Go to fcps.net/bus to update your information and register for the bus.

Dismissal from School

- We dismiss walkers first
- We then dismiss part of our bus riders
- Next we dismiss car riders and the rest of our bus riders
- Cars line up in the pick up circle
- If you are going to park on the street to pick up your child, please have them cross at the crosswalk by the entrance to the pick up circle. Also, please be a good neighbor to the homes around our school.
- If your student is participating in an activity at Lafayette or Dunbar, just have them leave with the walkers.

6th Grade Teacher Info
