Schedule Correction Requests

If you believe there is an error, submit a Schedule Correction Request using the link [here](#). Only one request may be submitted per student, and all approved changes are final. Approved changes will be updated in Infinite Campus before the first day of school.

Schedule correction requests are limited to:

- Missing class periods
- Missing graduation requirements (seniors)
- Incorrect course level placement (standard vs. advanced/rigorous)
- Missing prerequisites or courses already completed (including Summer School or eSchool)
- Dropping an elective for a study hall

Requests that cannot be accommodated include:

- Teacher requests
- Specific class periods or section changes
- Schedule changes to be with friends or the same lunch period

Students requesting changes outside these guidelines may visit the Counseling Office during the first five days of school. Changes will be considered based on course availability and parent/guardian approval.

Important Reminders

- Schedules are tentative and may change before school begins as enrollment, staffing, and class sizes are finalized.
- Final schedules will be available in Infinite Campus before school starts and printed for students on the first day of school.

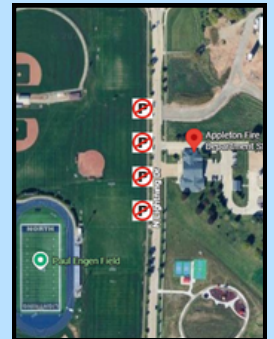

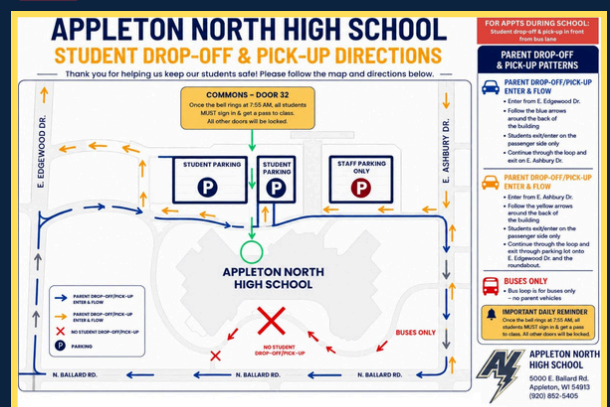

HOW TO REPORT STUDENT ABSENCES & APPOINTMENTS

APPLETON NORTH HIGH SCHOOL

ABSENCE PROCEDURES

To report an absence, a parent or legal guardian:

- Call the North Attendance Office at (920) 852-5405. Press 1 for Attendance, then **Press 1 to report an illness or Press 2 for appointments and other absences.** Please call as early as possible on the day of the absence.
- If leaving a message, please speak slowly and clearly. Include the **student's full name (spell the last name)**, grade, and reason for the absence to ensure we record the correct information.
- Press 7 for a Hmong interpreter or Press 8 for a Spanish interpreter. Please leave a message, and an interpreter will return your call.
- Messages are checked continually throughout the day.

The fastest way to report an absence is through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal. Submit an **Absence Request** to notify the school in advance. Learn more in the Portal!

TARDY PROCEDURES

School starts at 7:55 AM daily

- 1 A warning bell will ring at 7:45 AM daily notifying students that they have 10 minutes to get to their class.
- 2 If a student arrives after the 7:55 AM bell, they must sign in through the Commons door, whether excused or tardy. After 8:10 AM, all check-ins must be completed in the Main Office.
- 3 After a student has 5 tardies in a semester, they will receive a detention.

ILLNESS (ABSENCE FOR THE ENTIRE DAY)

All student illnesses must be called in advance to the Attendance Office by a parent or legal guardian at (920) 852-5405. Press 1 for Attendance, then **Press 1** for Illness.

Report illness absences through the **Campus Parent Portal** by submitting an **Absence Request**. Learn more in the Portal!

HEALTH ROOM & ILLNESS (LOCATED IN STUDENT SERVICES)

If your student becomes ill during the school day, they should report to the Health Room in Student Services.

If your student contacts you directly, please ask them to go to the Health Room first. Once evaluated by the nurse, they may call a parent/guardian to discuss next steps.

Following this process helps avoid confusion and delays for families and office staff.

APPOINTMENTS (LEAVING DURING SCHOOL DAY)

All student appointments must be called in advance to the Attendance Office by a parent or legal guardian at (920) 852-5405. Press 1 for Attendance, then **Press 2** for Appointments or Other Absences.

- Once the parental call has been made to excuse the student, they can notify the teacher of the appointment.
- The student **MUST** sign-out in the Main Office upon leaving the building.
- Upon returning to school, the student must sign back in the Main Office. Parents **DO NOT** need to come in when picking up or dropping off your student.
- Freshman leaving school for Lunch Hour must have a parent call in or come in the Main Office for pick up to be excused.

If your student needs to leave school and you are unable to call ahead, please Press 3 to speak directly with Student Services. Leaving a voicemail may delay the checkout process.

Students are responsible for knowing their appointment times and reporting to the Main Office when it is time to leave. To avoid disrupting instruction, we do not call students out of class unless it is an emergency.

PLEASE NOTE: A provider's note is required for medical or dental appointments and any extended absences due to illness.

ADVANCED ABSENCES (PARENT REQUEST)

- A parent/guardian may request that a student be excused from school attendance prior to an absence occurring.
- The student may be excused by the parent or guardian under this provision for not more than 10 days in the school year.

MEDICATIONS @ SCHOOL

All medications administered by school staff are only available to students during school hours (7:30 AM to 3:30 PM).

Medications should be administered at home whenever possible. Parents/guardians are urged to consult with the prescribed practitioner to determine if medications can be scheduled outside school hours. In the event that this is not possible, designated school staff will administer medication according to District policy.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION

- Complete the Medication Consent Form**
A current Medication Consent Form, signed by both the parent/guardian and prescribing provider, must be on file at school.
- Provide the medication**
Send the medication in its original pharmacy-labeled container. The label must match the consent form, and only the amount needed at school should be sent.

Submit updates if the prescription changes

If the medication dosage or instructions change, provide a new Medication Consent Form and an updated pharmacy-labeled container.

Per the AASD medication policy, non-FDA-approved medications cannot be administered.

AASD MEDICATION FORMS

**NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION
(OVER-THE-COUNTER)**

The parent/guardian must complete a Medication Consent Form. Medication must be in its original manufacturer's packaging and labeled with the student's name. Medication in other containers (such as plastic bags) will not be accepted.

SELF-MEDICATION

Students are discouraged from carrying and self-administering medication. If a parent/guardian requests this, they must contact the school nurse to discuss the request and complete the required form.

Absent Request

Parents can use this feature instead of calling the school office to report an absence.

STUDENT PARKING PERMITS



Available August 10

P A valid 2026–27 parking permit is required to park on campus. Permits are \$5 and **must be renewed annually**. Expired permits will result in a parking ticket.

🚗 One permit is issued per family and may be used on multiple registered vehicles.

📄 Complete the [application](#) (scan QR code) or pick up a form in the Main Office. A driver's license, vehicle make, model, color and license plate number(s) are required. Students must read the form and agree to the rules and to be responsible, respectful, and safe drivers.

📍 Parking permits are limited. Students without a permit may park on Ashbury Drive and must follow all posted city parking restrictions.

⚠️ Parking is a privilege. Permits may be revoked for disciplinary reasons, excessive tardiness, or failure to meet school expectations.

🚫 Park only in white-lined student parking spaces. Blue-lined spaces in the back lot near Ashbury are reserved for staff only. Vehicles parked in staff spaces or other unauthorized areas will be ticketed.

🛡️ A parking permit does not guarantee a space. If the lot is full, please use available street parking on Ashbury.

How to Submit

- Scan and email your photo if you only have a printed copy.

Photo Requirements

- Vertical, head-and-shoulders portrait only
- Full color (no filters, black & white, or sepia)
- Neutral, non-distracting background
- Appropriate attire (no hats or inappropriate graphics)
- No props, pets, friends, vehicles, or other distractions
- Submit photos ready for use; the yearbook staff will not edit or crop images

Photos that do not meet requirements may be rejected. **If no senior photo is submitted by the deadline, your school ID photo will be used if available.**

Direct Admit Wisconsin allows eligible seniors to receive admission offers from up to 10 Universities of Wisconsin campuses—no application fee required.

☑ Qualifying students will receive admission offers in their AASD email on August 1.

If your student receives an offer, review their options, visit campuses, and complete the university's Direct Admit form. Students who do not receive an offer can still apply through the regular admissions process. The Wisconsin Guarantee

The Wisconsin Guarantee provides guaranteed admission criteria for high-achieving students. Students who rank in the top 10% of their graduating class are guaranteed admission to any University of Wisconsin campus, except UW-Madison, which guarantees admission to students in the top 5%.

Class rank is determined at the end of junior year and is noted on students' transcripts for college applications. Eligible students will see their Wisconsin Guarantee status on their transcripts beginning in early August.

Appleton Area School District offers three programs for eligible high school students wanting to enroll in courses through a University of Wisconsin two- or four-year campus, tribally controlled college, or participating private, nonprofit college/university in Wisconsin. The requirements are included in the table below. The application may be accessed by clicking on the link in each of the columns. The deadline to enroll in a *spring semester course* is October 1st of each academic school year. The deadline to enroll in a *fall semester course* is March 1st of each academic school year. If you have any questions please reach out to your School Counselor.

Start College Now

- Enrollment within Wisconsin Technical Colleges
- Available to 11th and 12th grade students.
- Students must have a cumulative high school grade point average of at least 2.0 at the time of the determination.
- The district board may reject an application from a pupil who has a record of disciplinary problems, as determined by the district board.
- Summer courses are not eligible.
- Students cannot participate in the Start College Now Program and the Early College Credit Program simultaneously.

Early College Credit Program

- Enrollment within University of Wisconsin System institutions, tribally controlled colleges, private nonprofit institutions of higher education. Does not include Wisconsin Technical Colleges.
- Available to 9-12 grade students.
- Summer courses are eligible.
- Students cannot participate in the Start College Now Program and the Early College Credit Program simultaneously.

High School Co-Curricular Forms (Grades 9-12) – Required for students participating in co-curricular activities and require **both parent/guardian and student signatures**.

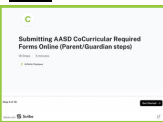
Please note: Athletic forms are not considered complete until **both signatures are submitted**. Forms expire at the end of each school year and must be completed annually.

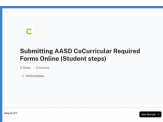

Sports Physicals CHEAT SHEET

Physical taken on April 1 or **after** of current year is valid for:

- The following 2 years, with an alternate year card in year
- Ex: Physical taken on April 1, 2026 (**or after**)
 - Physical good for 2026-2027 school year.
 - Alternate Year Card for the 2027-2028 school year.
 - Will need a new physical going into the 2028-2029 school year.



Physical taken **before** April 1 of current year is valid for:

- the remainder of that year and good for the following year with an alternate year card filled out.
- Ex: Physical taken **before** April 1, 2026
 - Alternate year card is good for the 2026-2027 school year.
 - Will need a new physical going into the 2027-2028 school year.

Any Physical prior to April 1, 2025 needs to be renewed!



Important REMINDER

Most athletic forms for the upcoming school year will be completed online. However, a new physical exam must be submitted as a paper copy (signed by a medical professional) before participating in practices or tryouts.

Before Practice/Tryouts:

- New Physical Exam – Paper copy submitted to the Main Office
- Alternate Year Card – Completed online (if applicable)

Before Competition:

- Concussion & Sudden Cardiac Arrest Agreement – Completed online
- AASD & ThedaCare Consent to Treat Form – Completed online
- Permit & Liability Form – Completed online
- WIAA Eligibility Form – Completed online
- Code of Conduct Agreement – Completed on the North Athletics website

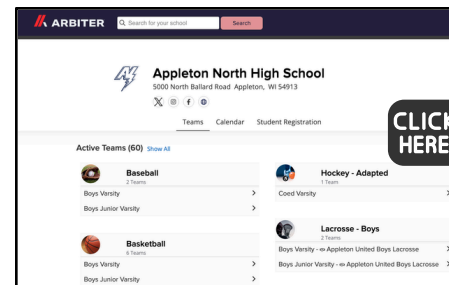

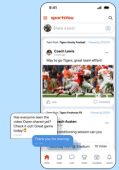
