Rush-Henrietta Central School District is committed to providing a safe and welcoming learning community. As we celebrate our district's 80th Anniversary, R-H is committed to building on our legacy by accomplishing the goals established in our Vision 2037 Strategic Plan. One of these goals is a transition to long-range capital improvement planning that will position our district to address academic program enhancements and preserve our infrastructure in a manner that is both timely and fiscally responsible.

The district and Board of Education gathered feedback in recent years from building principals, teachers, staff, families, students, community members, and safety experts. We are pleased to announce we are presenting our next capital improvement project for a public vote December 15, 2026.

2026 Capital Improvement Project Goals

The 2026 Capital Improvement Project is focused on safety and security, academic program space enhancements, and asset preservation. Areas that have been identified for the 2026 Capital Improvement Project impact nearly all district schools and buildings and include:



Safety and Security Improvements

- ▶ Secured vestibules at Burger Junior High and Webster Learning Center
- ▶ Fire alarm upgrades and replacement to maintain safety for students/staff
- ▶ Parking & traffic flow improvements at Vollmer Elementary School
- ▶ Access road and parking for new athletic fields at Senior High School



Academic Program Space Enhancements

- ▶ Transform our K-3 libraries into modern learning spaces
- ▶ Classroom renovations
- ▶ Enhance large gathering spaces (cafeteriums, auditoriums, gyms)
- ▶ New baseball, softball, and soccer fields behind the Senior High School
- ▶ Playground replacements



Asset Preservation & Infrastructure Improvements

- ▶ Boiler replacements
- ▶ Hot water system upgrades
- ▶ Electrical infrastructure upgrades (inside and outside buildings)
- ▶ Masonry repairs and repointing
- ▶ Preserve physical integrity of school buildings for the next generation
