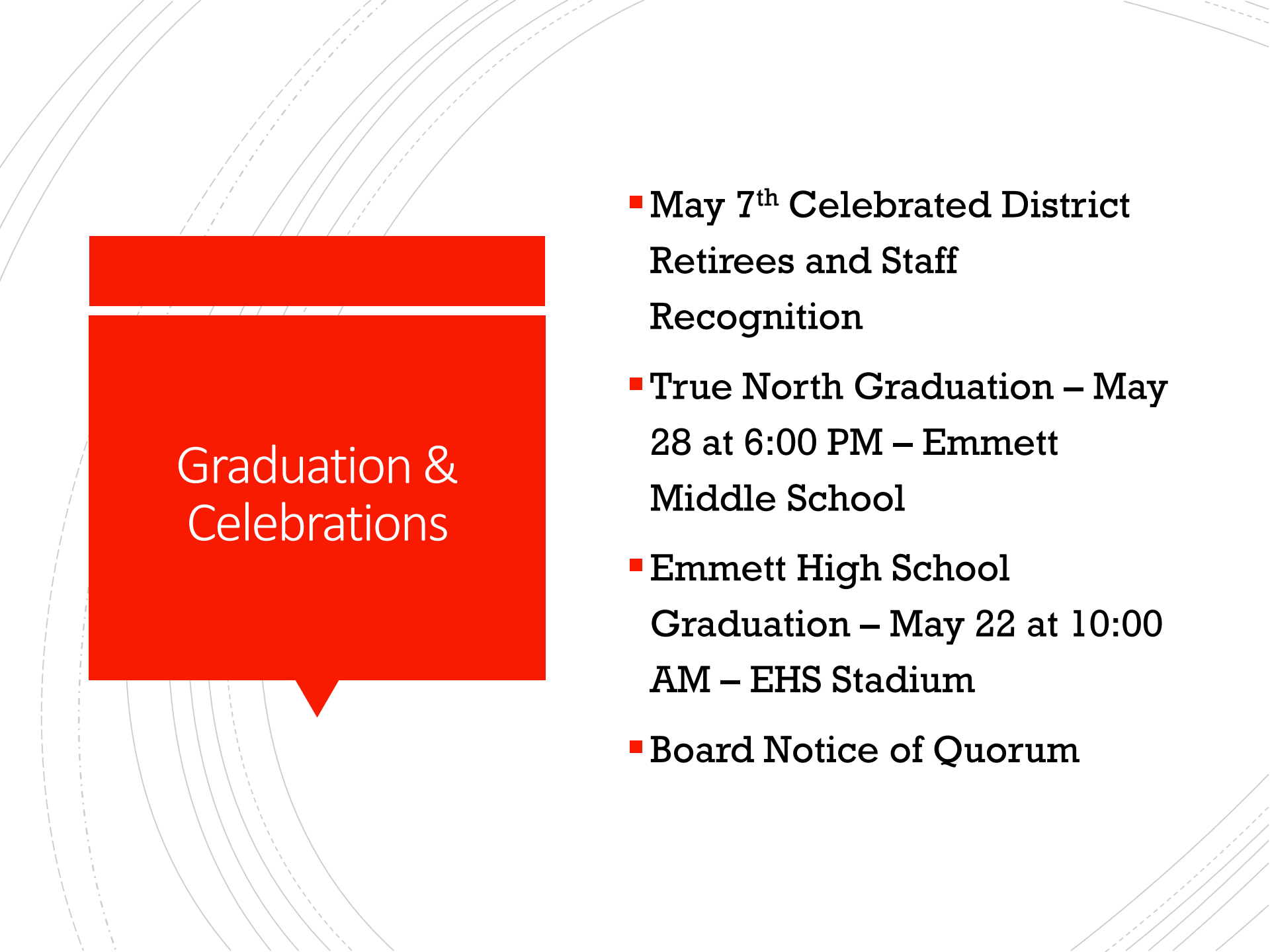

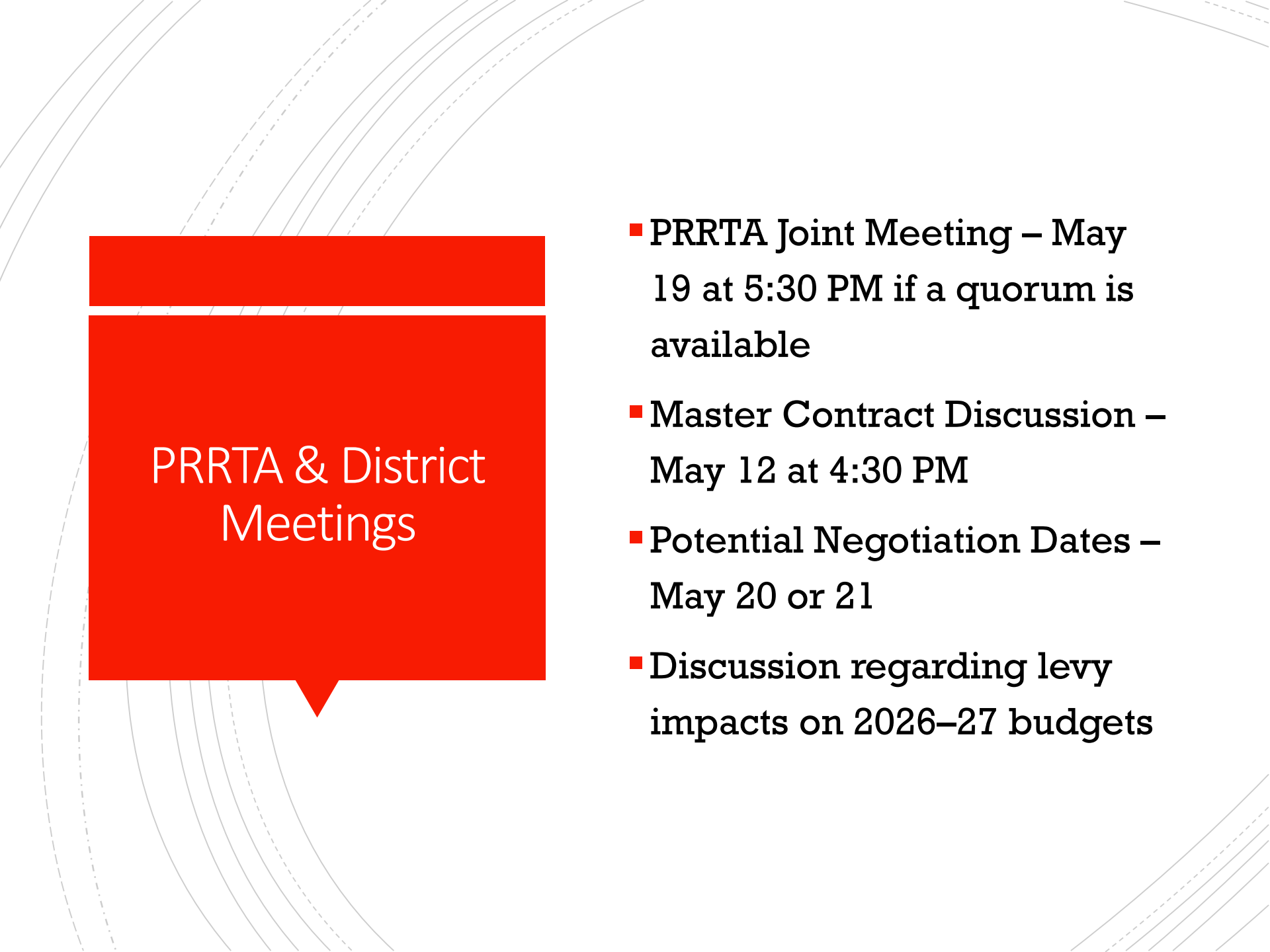

- Focus areas include behavioral support, nurses, maintenance, and classroom resources

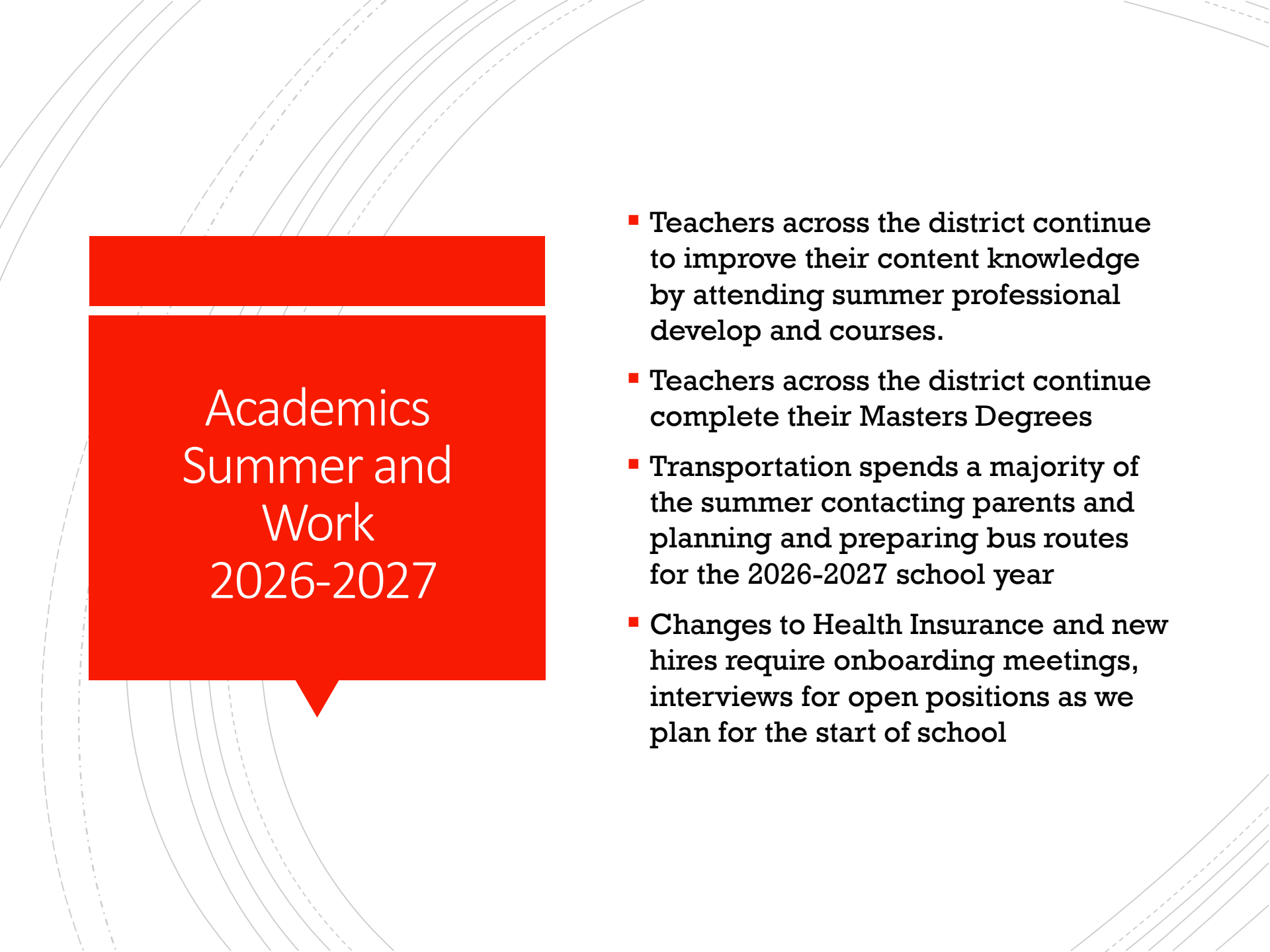
Academics, Scheduling and Staffing for 2026- 2027

- Elementary and Secondary Master schedules are close to being completed for 2026-2027. Principals are waiting for the election results before finalizing schedules



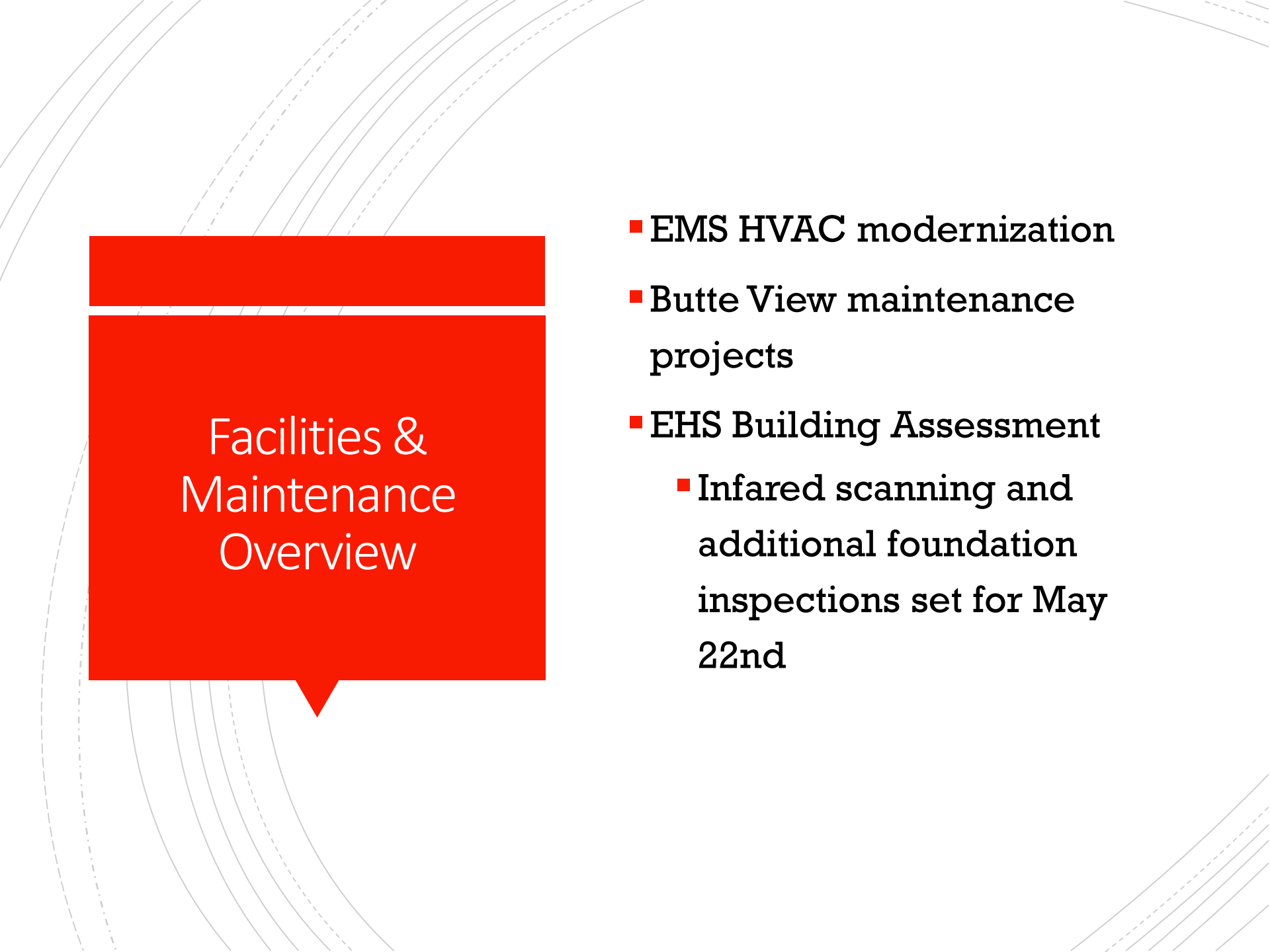
Academics Summer and Professional Learning Community 2026-2027

- June 8th through 11th Elementary Lead Teachers will attend training on the newly adopted Math Curriculum
- Target River Update
 - 22 contact leads since April
 - Approximately 50% have been asking for additional information or information regarding registering Kindergarten-age students
- August 5th and 6th Bridges Professional Development for all K-5 classroom teachers and teacher support
- The State Department of Education has selected Emmett School District for Cohort 2
- SDE will provide support for 6-12 Grade Professional Learning Building Coalitions as well as a District Level PLC Guiding Coalition
- Regional Math Center will continue with K-12 support of mathematics across the district. K-5 focus will be supporting the implementation of the Bridges Curriculum, Secondary Support Specific to Math Content Teachers.



Academics Summer and Work 2026-2027

- Teachers across the district continue to improve their content knowledge by attending summer professional develop and courses.
- Teachers across the district continue complete their Masters Degrees
- Transportation spends a majority of the summer contacting parents and planning and preparing bus routes for the 2026-2027 school year
- Changes to Health Insurance and new hires require onboarding meetings, interviews for open positions as we plan for the start of school

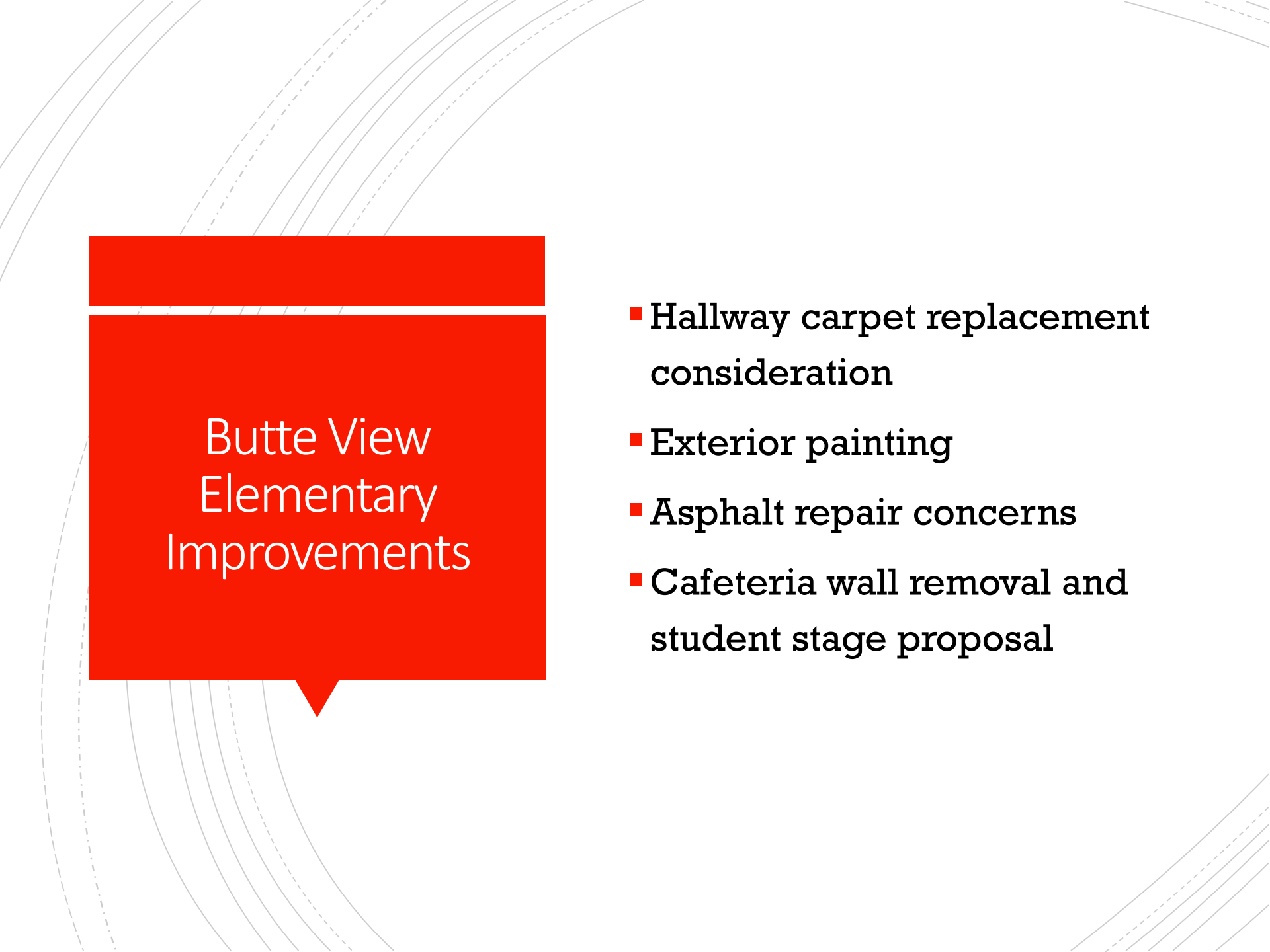
