

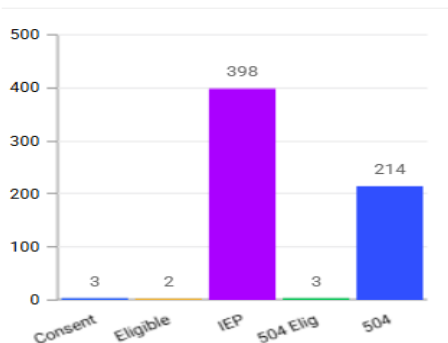


Special Education Monthly Board Report Emmett School District June, 2026

Special Education Demographics:

As of June 9, 2026, the home page of our IEP platform (Edplan) shows that 398 students are receiving Special Education, holding steady from May. We will pick up 3 Consents for Evaluation as we return in August, as well as process any move-ins or exits we may have over the summer

Staff Openings:

We have an open Special Education Hiring Pool to begin identifying anticipated openings for the 2026/27 school year.

- One Special Education Resource Room Teacher at Shadow Butte
- One School Psychologist.

Department Projects:
