From the Tribe of Asher



Dear all,
I am reprinting here part of the homily which I gave on God's plan for marriage and family at the 10:00 am and 12:30 pm Mass on Sunday, July 26. See below!

Marriage and family are one of the greatest goods of our lives. As such, they often become the greatest targets for the evil one. There are forces in our world and culture which are destructive for the family.

You and I need to be aware of them. In being aware of them, we can find the truth in God and His plan. So what is God's plan for marriage and family? How do we become holy in marriage and in family? What virtues do we need to practice in order to live holiness in marriage and family? Five virtues come to mind: time, faith, generosity, mercy, and hope.

First, time. Jordan Peterson says that couples need to put in 90 minutes a week into intentional problem solving—talking about how work is going, how kids are doing, what needs to be done at home, what financial issues or logistical issues are coming up. But not only that, Peterson says that couples should spend 3-4 hours a week on courtship. This is not problem solving; that's what the other 90 minutes are for. Courtship, rather, is continually practicing love for each other, going on a date, spending time with each other. Maybe those goals are unreasonable for us, but if we even put in 25% of that amount time into intentionally growing in marriage and family, that would go a long way for our marriages and families.

We cannot sacrifice marriage for family. This happens all too often. Parents with children forget to prioritize their marriage! The reality is that children need to know that you as parents love each other. This is even more important than children knowing that you love them. When children know that mom and dad love each other, then everything else is okay. Because they are safe. We need to put in time to grow in love in our relationships.

Second, faith. To be holy in marriage parents need to model the faith. If children do not see you model the faith at home, then the chances that faith takes root are far less. This is especially true for fathers. Statistics show that if a father is actively leading his family in faith (not just practicing the faith; leading the family in faith), children are far more likely to practice their faith as adults. Children are mimics. If you as parents practice the faith—own the faith—again, especially fathers—children see that and will imitate that. They need to know that you not only go to Church but that you want to go to Church every Sunday. They need to see you pray, at church and at home.

Third, generosity. July 25 marked the 58th anniversary of a letter written by Pope Paul VI—*Humanae Vitae*—translated into English as *On Human Life*—a letter which simply reaffirms the Church's constant teaching from the very beginning on why contraception is harmful to married love. Contraception reduces the act of total giving of oneself in marriage to a lie, whereby, though the bodies are saying everything I have is yours, in fact, because of what's being practiced, that's not true. The widespread use of contraceptives in our culture has not produced happiness; it has produced destruction. I know that to follow the Church's teaching on this matter is not easy. It requires sacrifice, generosity, and trust in the Lord. And yet, it is the way to happiness. It is a lie that our own plans for our lives are better. Our own plans do not make us happy. God's plan is always more.

Fourth, mercy. There is no perfect marriage. There is no perfect family. For marriage and family to thrive, God's invitation is to forgive, to forgive, and to forgive. To never keep score. All of us have wounds in our lives that lead us to sin. And while that woundedness is the raw material for problems, it is also the raw material for God's grace and mercy to enter. The lifelong union of marriage requires a continual commitment to mercy and forgiveness.

Fifth, hope. Hope that each family in this parish is precious to our heavenly Father. Hope that even in our weaknesses and struggles, Jesus Christ sustains us. Hope that even if things in our marriages and families have not gone as planned, and even if we feel like we are on plan B or C or D, God does not abandon us. He is a God of second chances, and third chances, and fourth chances, and even more. Hope that no matter where we have been, no matter what we are going through right now, God's plan for us is for our welfare, not for doom. Hope that God writes beautiful stories of redemption on the crooked and wayward lines of our lives. To be holy is not about trying harder. It is about relying more deeply on God and His grace given to us in Jesus.
