



Spring Lake Park High School Student Parking Guide

Thank you for helping keep our parking lots safe, organized and accessible for everyone. Please review the parking expectations below before parking on campus.

Parking Expectations

During the school day (7 a.m.-3 p.m.), students may park only in the designated student parking lots.

- **Main Student Parking Lot:** East side of campus near Highway 65 and 79th Avenue
- **Overflow Student Parking Lot:** East of the staff parking lot along the Highway 65 service road



To help keep our campus safe, students are expected to:

- Display your parking permit on the inside bottom-right corner of your windshield so it is clearly visible.
- Park only in designated student parking areas.
- Lock your vehicle whenever it is parked on campus. Spring Lake Park Schools is not responsible for theft of or damage to vehicles.
- Drive safely and responsibly at all times.
- Yield to pedestrians throughout the parking lots.
- Help keep the parking lots clean by disposing of trash properly.
- Use only the permit issued to you. Parking permits may not be sold, shared or transferred to another student.
- Remain on campus during the school day unless you have permission to leave. Leaving without permission may result in the suspension or loss of parking privileges.

The student who completes the parking permit application is responsible for any violations associated with that permit.

Parking Violations

Parking expectations help ensure a safe campus for everyone. Students who do not follow these expectations may receive a parking citation, have a wheel boot placed on their vehicle, be towed at the owner's expense or loss parking privileges. Common parking violations include:

- Parking in staff or visitor parking areas
- Parking without a valid permit displayed
- Reckless driving
- Littering
- Leaving school during the day without permission
- Misusing or transferring a parking permit

Parking Violation Consequences

- 1st Violation – ticket issued, \$10 fine
- 2nd Violation – ticket issued, \$10 fine; parent/guardian notified that a third violation will result in a wheel boot
- 3rd Violation – vehicle will receive a wheel boot; \$25 removal fee
- 4th Violation – vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense. Parent/guardian notification will be sent prior to towing.

Thank you for helping keep our parking lots safe and respectful to everyone! We appreciate your cooperation in following these expectations throughout the school year.

Public schools are effectively private property, owned by the local school board. They can decide who is and is not allowed on campus, who is permitted to drive on campus, etc. School Districts can have unauthorized vehicles towed away. Driving a private vehicle to school is not a necessity or a right, therefore it is at the discretion of the school whether to charge for the privilege to secure a parking spot. Please be advised that Spring Lake Park High School parking lots are under video surveillance.
