Lunch:

PK \$2.75

CHARGE POLICY

Students may charge meals up to the value of two breakfasts and two lunches. An automated phone call and email occurs when a negative balance appears on a student's account. If a student account exhausts the grace period/charge limit, the student must select a peanut butter and jelly or toasted cheese sandwich entree for lunch and/or a cereal entrée for breakfast until the negative balance is paid.
