- The guest **attaches a copy of an official photo ID** to this form (ASB card, Driver's license, State ID card, etc.). Guest must also bring the ID to the dance.
- Student and guest must follow all policy rules and regulations as stated on the subsequent page.
- SHS students are responsible for the behavior of their guests.
- If you or your guest is asked to leave, both parties must leave.
- Each pass is verified for accuracy. **Any forged signatures result in forfeit of dance by both guest and student.**

GUEST PASS INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fill out the "SHS Student Information" section and have it signed by your parent or guardian.
2. Have your guest fill out the "Guest Information" section; **must include:**
 - a. Copy of their ASB card or Driver's license, based on the appropriate criteria.
 - b. Signed by SHS student's parent/guardian
 - c. Signed by guest parent/guardian
 - d. Signed by guest school administration with **ATTACHED BUSINESS CARD**
3. Bring your paperwork to Skyline and find a Skyline administrator to sign the guest pass form at the bottom. If an administrator is not available, leave the form at the front desk in the main office and pick it up after an administrator has signed it.
4. Turn in your **completed and signed** Guest Pass form to our ASB Bookkeeper to purchase your tickets.

DANCE POLICY

1. **All students must have picture ID to enter.** Accepted forms of ID are an ASB card, driver's license or passport.
2. **Once you leave the dance for any reason, you are not allowed back in.**
3. Behavior at school dances is monitored. Possession of or being under the influence of any controlled substance is prohibited. Parents and police will be contacted.
4. A breathalyzer may be used at the discretion of the officer on duty and the school administration.
5. Guest must be no younger than a ninth grader and no older than 20 years of age.
6. **Do not embarrass yourself.** Students may be removed from the dance without a refund for acting/dancing in an inappropriately sexual manner. Use your best judgment to decide what is and is not appropriate for a school event.
7. **Appropriate attire required.** Please dress appropriately for a school event or you may be asked to leave the dance.
8. **All school rules apply at this event.**

NOTE: Administration reserves the right to determine what is appropriate.
