

GaMTSS: GEORGIA MULTI-TIERED SYSTEM OF SUPPORTS

[Georgia Multi-Tiered System of Supports \(GaMTSS\)](#) is a data-driven, tiered framework that supports the whole child across academics, behavior, and wellbeing. By integrating data, systems, and practices, teams can identify barriers to learning and provide aligned supports.

GaMTSS is guided by [five essential components](#):

1. Data-Based Decision Making (DBDM)
2. Teaming
3. Multi-level Prevention
4. Evaluation
5. Infrastructure



GaMTSS supports District Leadership Teams (DLTs) in school improvement by building policies, procedures, professional learning, and infrastructure for implementation. DLTs begin with Tier I systems before expanding to advanced tiers. Districts with established DLTs supporting academics, behavior, and wellbeing may apply to become a GaMTSS Cohort District through the Georgia Department of Education. Approved districts receive up to three years of professional learning and coaching through a cascading support model with GaDOE Tiered Support Specialists and Metro RESA Whole Child Supports Coordinators.
