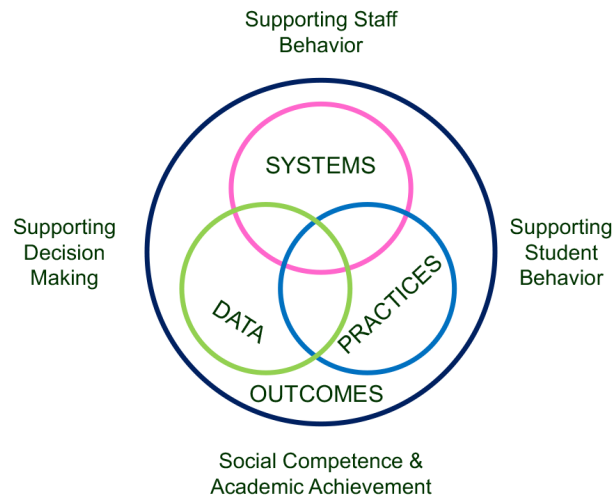
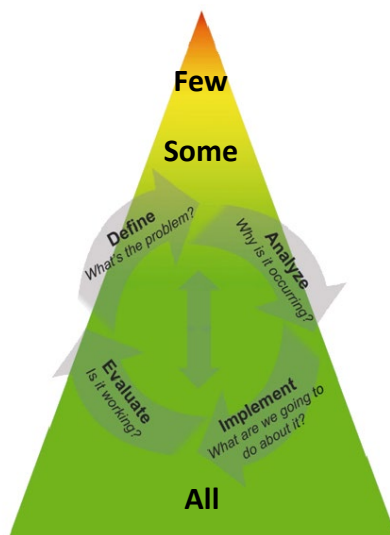

School Climate: The overall quality, values, and practices shaping a learning environment.

PBIS Framework: A proactive, multi-tiered approach to improving climate by teaching positive behaviors and using data-driven interventions.

Tiered Support: Delivers universal support for all students alongside targeted interventions for those with greater behavioral needs.
