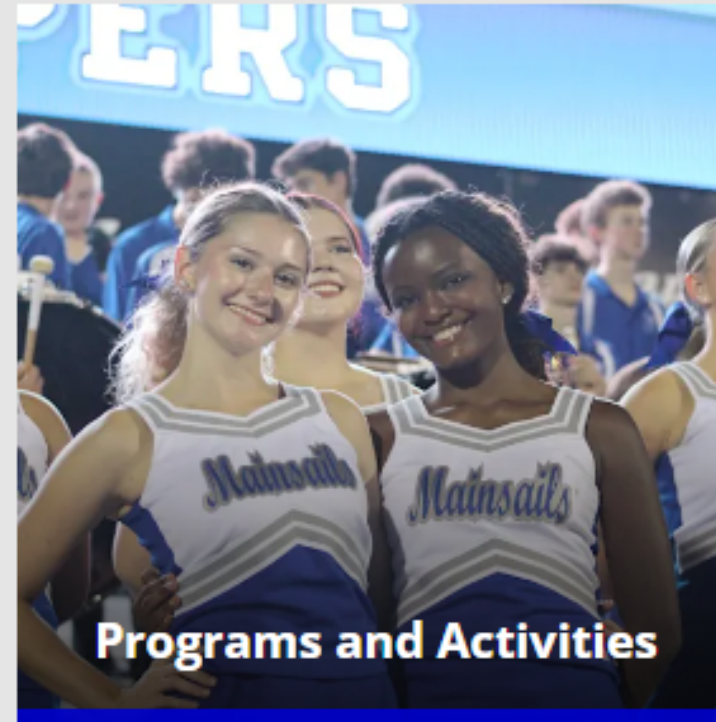
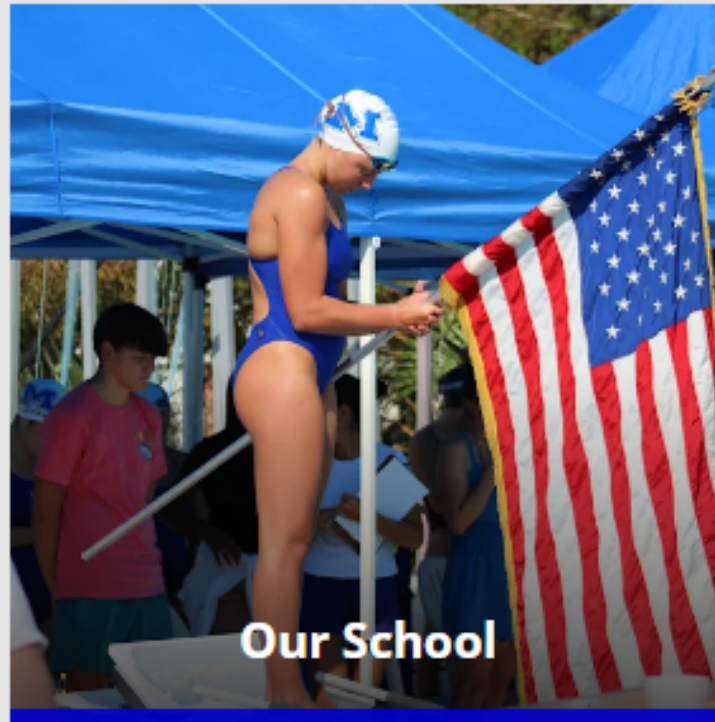
Freshman will be given a free yellow lanyard in homeroom.

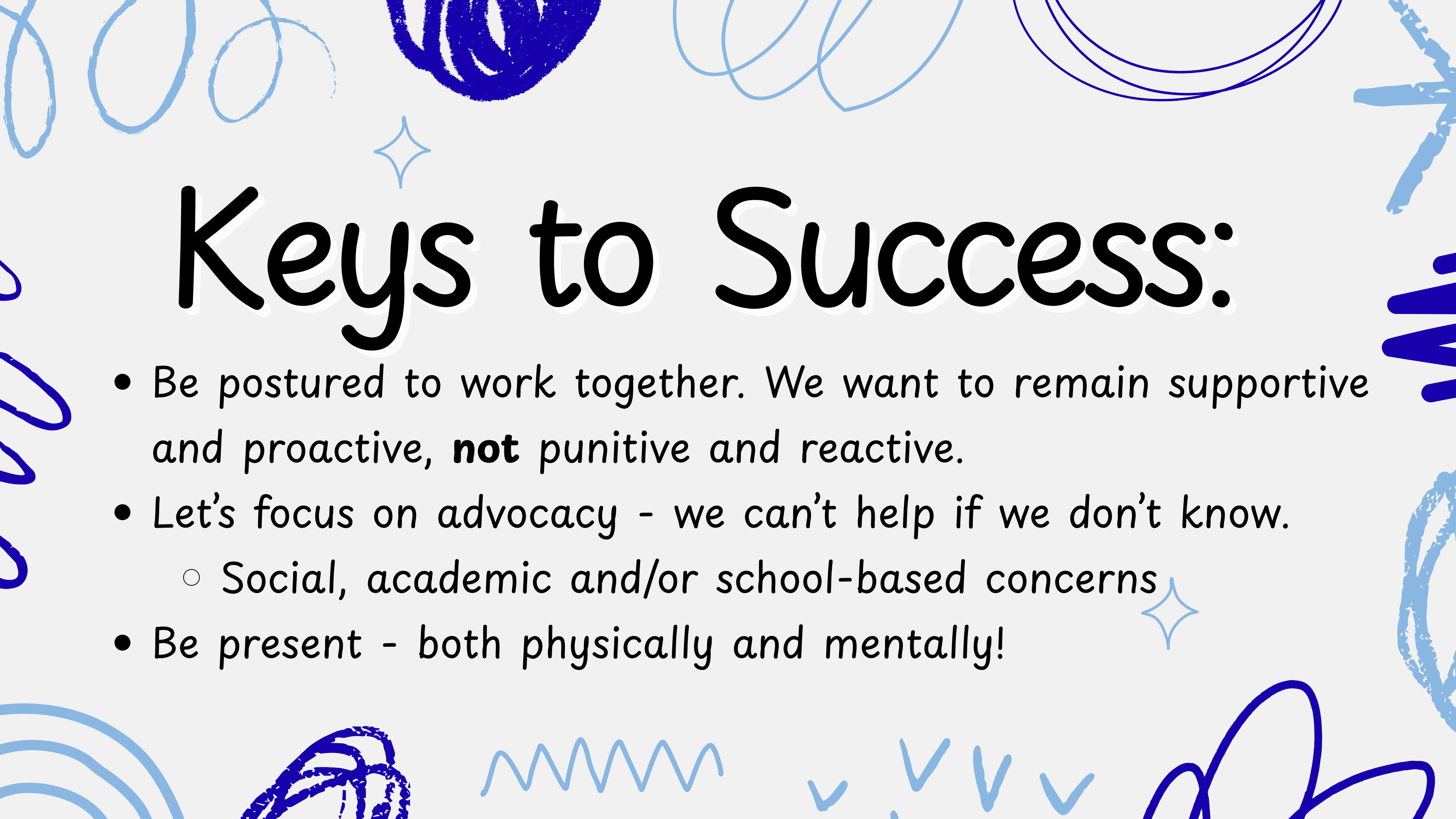

- Be present - both physically and mentally!



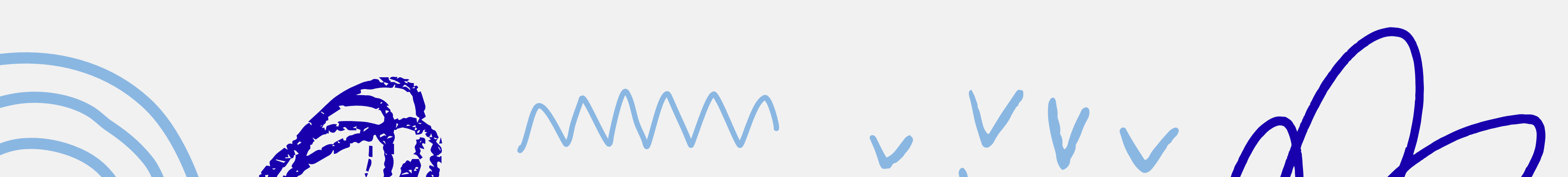
Carnegie Credits:

Sophomores - Must earn at least **11 credits** to advance

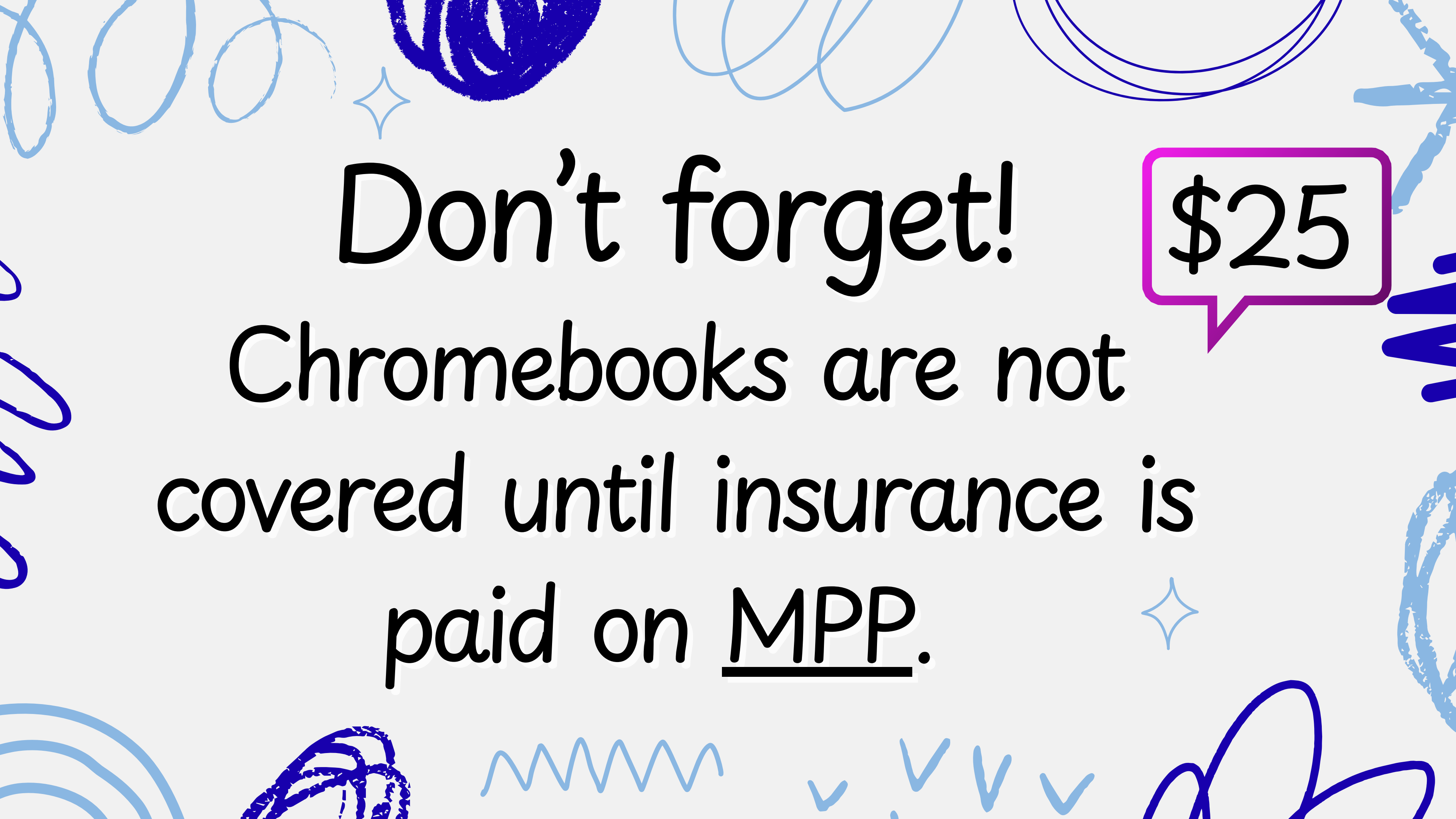
Juniors - Must earn at least **17 credits** to advance

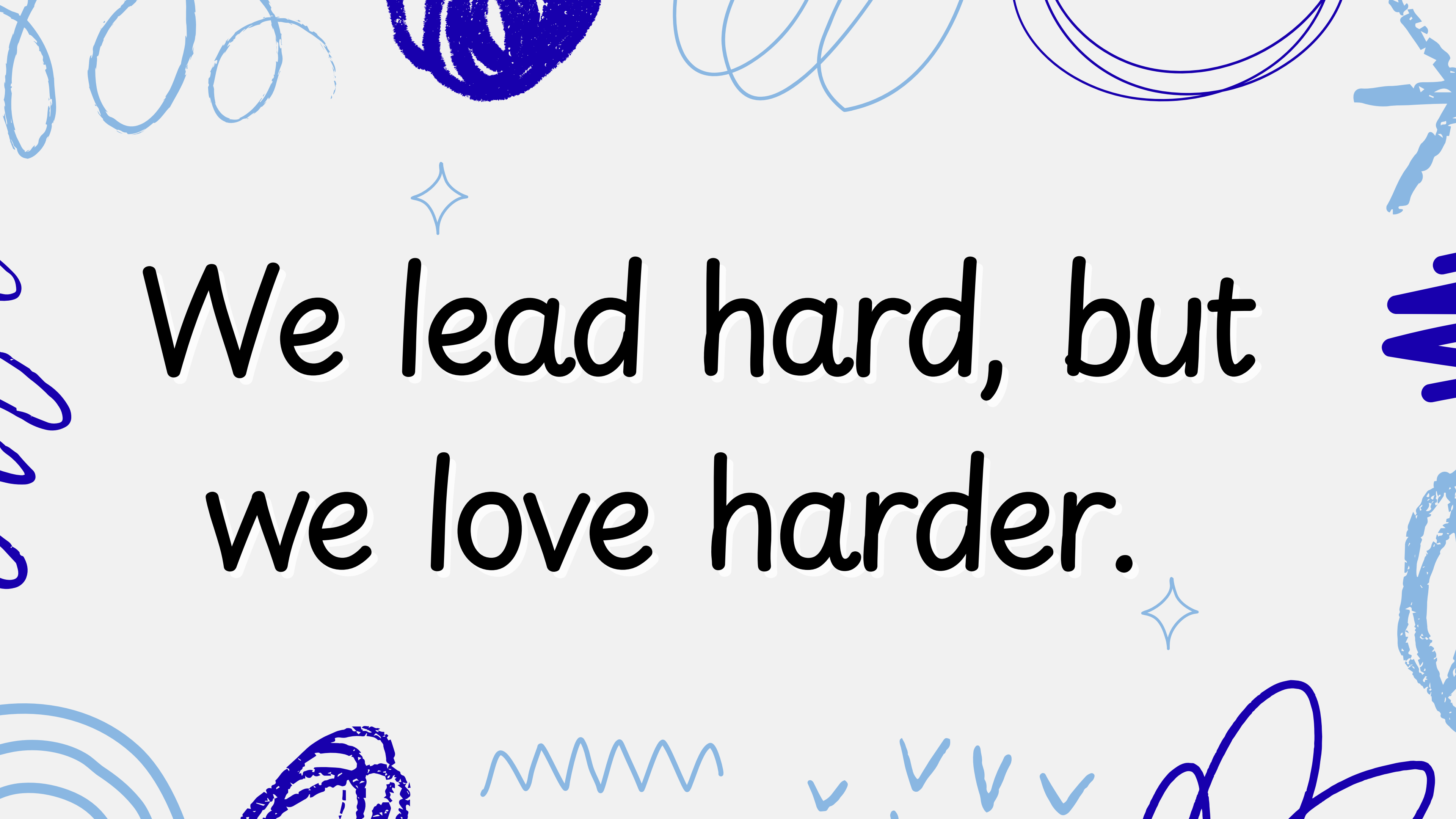
