School Parking Regulations

Students who apply for and receive permits fully understand their responsibility in the following rules:

1. **YOU MUST HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE**
2. Students may not share parking passes
3. The current year's permit must be clearly displayed in the rearview mirror or in the lower left corner of the windshield.
4. If there are multiple student drivers of any vehicle, all drivers must complete a Student Parking Permit Application.
5. Drivers who have just received their license must purchase a permit. The cost of the permit is \$30 for a yearly parking pass which is good for the current school year only. If purchasing a parking pass after the start of second semester, the fee will be \$15. **Once a permit is purchased, there will be no refunds for any reason.**
6. **ALL STUDENTS MUST PARK IN THE ATHLETICS COMPLEX PARKING LOT ONLY.**
7. All vehicles must be licensed and insured. The school is not responsible for the vehicle or its contents.
8. Students are expected to operate their motor vehicles in a reasonable, prudent and lawful manner. The speed limit on school grounds is 5 miles per hour.
9. Student vehicles may be subject to a search if there are reasonable grounds to believe that drugs, alcohol, stolen property, or other contraband could be present in that vehicle.
10. No vehicle is to have any occupancy during the school day. (The driver of the vehicle is responsible for this.)
11. All vehicles need to park precisely within the painted outlined areas and all vehicles should be locked.
12. **LOITERING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE PARKING LOT AT ANY TIME**
13. Violators may have their parking privileges restricted by the Principal or referred to law enforcement.
14. If your car is damaged on school grounds, please report it to the office immediately if during school hours (7:30am-3:00pm), if outside of school hours, report the incident to local law enforcement
15. All vehicles must have school appropriate images or text displayed, as determined by administration, on their vehicles at all times.
16. If a student's permit is suspended, no fees will be refunded.
17. Parking regulations are strictly enforced throughout school property. Parking on school grounds is considered a privilege. Failure to park in the correct location, not abiding by any of the regulations listed above or parking in the lot without a permit could lead to parking tickets being issued, suspension of parking privileges, vehicle towing at owners expense, and/or suspension from school may occur for violations of these regulations.

Eligibility for random drug testing without suspicion

All Luxemburg-Casco High School students applying for LC High School parking permits must consent to random, suspicionless drug testing. For a detailed description of Random Drug Testing Procedures and consequences, please refer to pages 9-10 of the Luxemburg-Casco High School Student Handbook.

As a parent, I understand that my child parking on school grounds is a privilege and, therefore, I agree that they will be subject to the school's parking regulations. I give my permission for my child to participate in random, suspicionless drug testing and authorize the testing and the release of information to the district regarding the results of such tests should they be randomly selected. I understand that the implementation of the program may require the release of directory data to the testing facility and that this may require me to complete the disclosure forms required by the testing facility to facilitate the release of test results from the facility to the district. I understand that this agreement is binding until my child graduates from high school.
