- Keep families informed about progress, events, and opportunities.

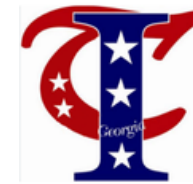

Our Goals for 2026-2027

1. By May 2027, our students in 3-5 will score at least 76.41% on the EOG, and the percentage of students meeting Lexile expectations will be: 66.7% for 3rd grade, 49.2% in 4th grade, and 71.7% in 5th grade. Additionally, at least 85% of students in K-5 will meet or exceed typical growth as measured by iReady.

2. By May 2027, 78.69% of students in grades 3-5 will achieve level 2 or above on EOG. Additionally, at least 85% of students in K-5 will meet or exceed typical growth as measured by iReady.

3. By May 2027, student attendance will increase by 3%, and at least 95% of students will report feeling safe, respected, and supported as measured by Panorama surveys, climate data, and stakeholder feedback.
