



International Leadership of Texas Child Nutrition Department Complaint Procedures

The following guidelines will be followed should anyone express discrimination from the International Leadership of Texas Child Nutrition Department (CND).

- Any person that approaches the Child Nutrition Program staff and claims they have been discriminated against will be assisted by the Child Nutrition staff to complete a Complaint Form. The Child Nutrition staff will assist the complainant with completing the Discrimination Complaint Form via <https://squaremeals.org/About/Contact-Food-and-Nutrition>, paper copy below, or electronically <https://forms.gle/a867D68aA49zrNk9>, writing, and/or verbally. See below for the instructions on how to complete the Discrimination Complaint Form via online and a written form.
- Any Child Nutrition staff can assist with the process. If the person chooses not to complete the form via online, the CND staff will assist the person by taking the information verbally and complete the form for the complainant. The CND staff will identify themselves as the person who transcribed the complaint on the Discrimination Complaint Form.
- The Discrimination Complaint Form, once completed or completed as best as possible, is forwarded to the Child Nutrition Executive Director (Larry Albritton at Lalbritton@iltexas.org).
- The Executive Director will forward the Discrimination Complaint Form to the Texas Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Division, Compliance Department. The Contracting Entity will not attempt to resolve the complaint without forwarding the complaint to TDA.
- Please email childnutrition@iltexas.org if you have any problems and/or concerns about the discrimination complaint process. Allow the ILTexas Child Nutrition Department to assist you during the process.

International Leadership of Texas Child Nutrition Department Complaint Procedures Spanish

Se seguirán las siguientes pautas si alguien manifiesta discriminación por parte del Liderazgo Internacional del Departamento de Nutrición Infantil de Texas (CND).

- Cualquier persona que se dirija al personal del Programa de Nutrición Infantil alegando haber sido objeto de discriminación recibirá ayuda de dicho personal para completar un formulario de queja. El personal de Nutrición Infantil asistirá a la persona reclamante para completar el Formulario de Queja por Discriminación a través de <https://squaremeals.org/About/Contact-Food-and-Nutrition> (o mediante la copia impresa que aparece más abajo), de forma electrónica en <https://forms.gle/a867D68aA49rzrNk9>, por escrito y/o verbalmente. A continuación, se incluyen las instrucciones para completar el Formulario de Queja por Discriminación, tanto en línea como en formato impreso.
- Cualquier miembro del personal de Nutrición Infantil puede ayudar con el proceso. Si la persona decide no completar el formulario en línea, el personal de CND le ayudará tomando la información verbalmente y completando el formulario en nombre del reclamante. El personal de CND se identificará como la persona que transcribió la queja en el Formulario de Queja por Discriminación.
- El Formulario de Queja por Discriminación, una vez completado o completado de la mejor manera posible, se envía al Director Ejecutivo de Nutrición Infantil (Larry Albritton, Lalbritton@iltexas.org).
- El Director Ejecutivo enviará el Formulario de Queja por Discriminación al Departamento de Agricultura de Texas, División de Alimentos y Nutrición, Departamento de Cumplimiento. La Entidad Contratante no intentará resolver la queja sin remitirla al TDA.
