The Motorcycle Safety Basic Rider Course is a public program created to improve your mental and physical skills for safe motorcycling. Learn how to manage risk and develop strategies to become a safe and responsible motorcyclist.

The Minimum Required Age is 14 years old. If less than 18, a parent or guardian **MUST** be present on the first day to sign a waiver. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

*Participants must complete a 5-hour long on-line training course prior to the start of class on Saturday. Also, **Attendance is required for successful completion of this course.***

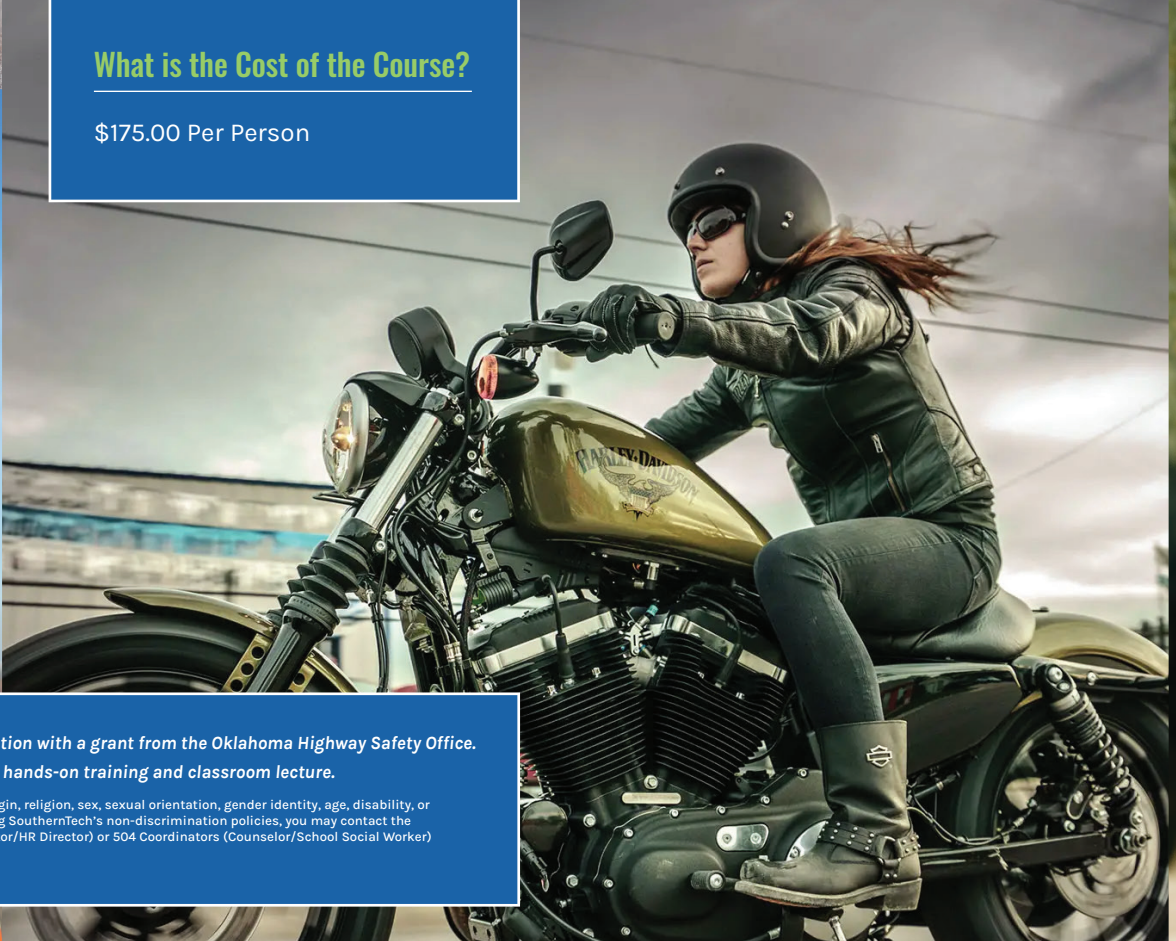
What are the Supplies Required for the Course?

- DOT or SNELL approved Helmet
- Sturdy, over-the-ankle Footwear
- Sturdy Long Pants
- Eye Protection
- Long-sleeved Shirt or Jacket
- Full Fingered Gloves

*Items listed above must be provided by the participant. **SouthernTech will provide a 250cc Motorcycle for use during class.***

Frequently Asked Questions

Who Should Take This Course?

Anyone planning on riding a motorcycle.

Anyone under the age of 18, by Oklahoma Law, must complete an MSF Course to obtain an "M" endorsement on their license.

What are the Instructor's Qualifications to Teach?

Our Instructors have successfully completed the MSF Basic Rider CourseSM Rider CoachSM Preparation Course, and they fully comply with the instructional guidelines recommended by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation.

Can I get my "M" Endorsement on my License by Completing this Course?

Successful completion of this course ensures you an "M" endorsement on your driver's license. Driving and written tests at the DMV will be waived.

Anyone under the age of 16 is required to take the "Rules of the Road" test at the DMV.

Can I Bring My Own Scooter Instead of Using a Motorcycle?

Students who may be approved to use their own scooter must provide the following:

Proof of Liability Insurance at or above \$25,000 personal injury, \$50,000 injury per occurrence, and \$10,000 property damage

Proof of Ownership or permission to use during the class

Owner's Registration

Permission for the instructor to conduct a pre-ride safety inspection

Will this Course Lower my Motorcycle Insurance?

All insurance companies maintain different policies regarding motorcycle insurance discounts. Some providers offer discount-incentives for completing a motorcycle rider safety course. Please contact your local insurance agent for further details.
