PROPOSITION 1

Replacement Educational Programs and Operations (EP&O) Levy

The EP&O Levy replaces the district's expiring three-year levy to continue funding for:

Learning Experiences:

- Smaller class sizes, athletics, and extracurricular activities, nutrition services, transportation
- Music and fine arts, highly capable programs
- Special Education teachers and paraeducators

School and Classroom Supports:

- Additional school nurses, psychologists, custodial staff, and paraeducators above what the state funds
- School Resource Officers (YES Officers)
- Substitute teachers and staff professional development
- Health aides, speech therapists

PROPOSITION 2

Replacement Capital Levy for Technology, Security and Infrastructure Improvements

The Capital Levy replaces an expiring levy to continue funding for:

- Student, teacher, and classroom technology to sustain our investment in learning technology
- Replacement cycle of student and staff devices
- Upgrades to our safety and security systems and infrastructure, including security cameras
