What is CPPI?

Gather Required Documents:

Child's Birth Certificate (original or certified copy)

On the Form:

If your child is 3 years old, select “EC” (Early Childhood)

If your child is 4 years old by September 1st, Select “PK” (Preschool)

Save LPS Account Login Information

- Keep your username & password in a safe place.
- If you live in Lowell, you will need this information when registering your child for Kindergarten.
