



MATER DEI CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL PARKING PERMIT POLICY

1. Only students with a valid driver's license or permit and proof of insurance are eligible to apply for a parking permit.
2. Students must complete the designated parking permit application form. Approval is subject to availability and fulfillment of all requirements.
3. Students must park in designated student parking areas. Student parking is allocated in front of the school under the solar panels. Each permit holder will be assigned a numbered parking space.
4. Students must park only in the numbered parking space assigned to them. Students may not park in another student's assigned space or any other unauthorized parking space without prior approval from Ms. Vaca or school administration. If a student's assigned space is occupied, the student must park temporarily in a designated visitor parking space and notify the Office of School Culture immediately. Students may not park in another student's assigned space without authorization.
5. Students may not exchange, share, or transfer their assigned parking space to another student without prior approval from school administration.
6. Students may not park on handicap parking, visitors parking, staff parking, or the church's parking lot.
7. Parking permits are valid for the academic year and must be renewed annually.
8. Permit holders must adhere to all school rules and regulations while on campus, including all posted traffic signs, safe driving practices, and speed limits in parking lots.
9. The parking permit must be prominently displayed on the vehicle's rearview mirror at all times while parked on school premises.
10. Parking permits are non-transferable and may only be used by the assigned student.
11. Students are not allowed to copy or resell MDCHS parking permits. Forgery and/or other dishonest behaviors involving parking will result in loss of parking privileges and/or disciplinary actions.

12. Providing false or misleading information on the parking permit application or during the registration process may result in denial or revocation of parking privileges and may lead to disciplinary action.
13. Students who drive a vehicle other than the one registered with the school must notify Ms. Vaca in advance and obtain a temporary parking permit for that vehicle.
14. Students must notify Ms. Vaca within five (5) school days of any permanent change to their registered vehicle, license plate, or insurance information. Failure to update this information may result in the suspension or revocation of parking privileges.
15. By parking on school property, students consent to vehicle searches if school officials have reasonable suspicion of any violation.
16. Vehicles parked on school property must be legally registered, insured, and maintained in safe operating condition. The school reserves the right to deny parking privileges to vehicles that do not meet these requirements.
17. The school is not liable for any damages, theft, or accidents that occur to vehicles parked on the premises.
18. Students may not loiter in the parking lot or remain in any vehicle at any time. Smoking, vaping, or using drugs in or around vehicles is strictly prohibited.
19. Parking privileges may be revoked due to poor attendance, excessive tardiness, disciplinary issues, or repeated violations of the terms and conditions.
20. Any accidents, damage, or suspicious activity involving vehicles on school grounds must be reported immediately to MDCHS Security, regardless of fault or liability.
21. Students are not allowed to park overnight, unless approved by school administration.
22. Lost permits must be reported to the office immediately. Replacement permits may require a fee.
23. Parking regulations are strictly enforced. Violations of these terms and conditions may result in warnings, revocation of parking privileges, towing at the owner's expense, or other disciplinary action.
24. Students must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local traffic laws while operating a vehicle on school property. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action and/or loss of parking privileges.
