



Dear SEDOL Community,

To enhance the safety and well-being of our school community, SEDOL has strengthened our entry protocols across all managed facilities in accordance with Board Policy 8:30. These proactive security enhancements allow us to maintain a secure, welcoming, and supportive environment for all students, staff, and visitors.

Visitor Check-In Process Upon arrival, all visitors—defined as anyone other than an enrolled student or SEDOL employee—are asked to check in at the Verkada Guest kiosk located in the vestibule.

- **Identification:** Visitors 18 years of age and older should present a state-issued ID or driver's license for a quick electronic screening.
- **Access Approval:** To maintain a secure perimeter, the door connecting the vestibule to the main office remains locked during check-in. Entry beyond the vestibule is granted once the screening is approved and verified by school personnel.
- **Parent & Guardian Accommodations:** As part of this enhanced policy, we recognize that a parent, guardian, or sibling of an enrolled student may not always have a state-issued ID on hand. In these instances, alternative security verification steps are available so you can access the building for matters related to your student.

This layered approach is a key component of our ongoing efforts to safeguard our learning community while continuing to provide a warm, accommodating experience for our families.
