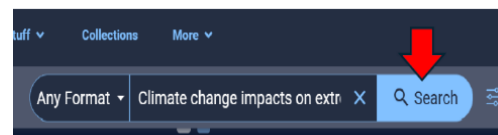

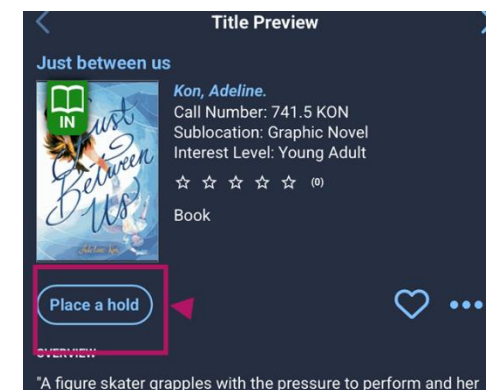
Navigate Search Results

Search results are organized on four tabs: **Books**, **Collections**, **Websites** and **Databases**.



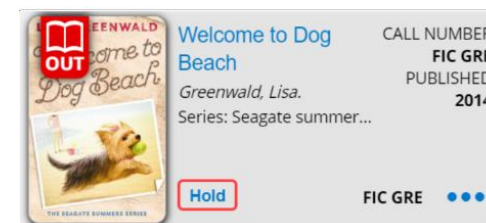
Books

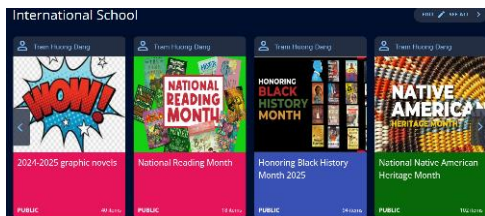
How to put a hold in Destiny Discover

From the home page, search results, Title Preview or a title's details then click **Hold**.



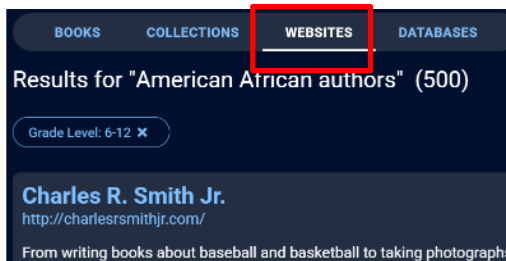
