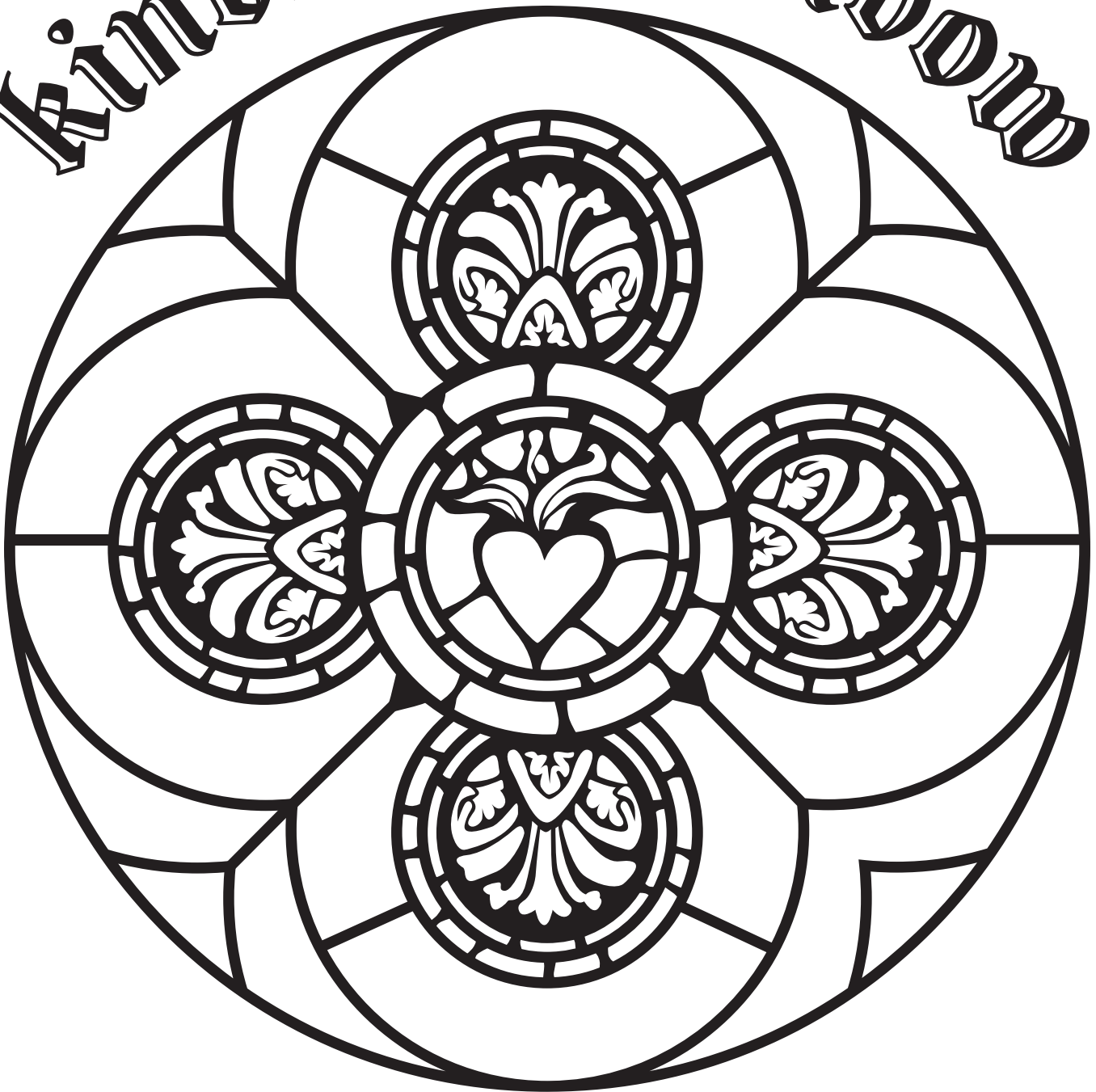

Color Your Way Through History



The Irvine Memorial Chapel represents 30 years of planning by Mercersburg's founder and first headmaster Dr. William Mann Irvine and his wife, Camille.

Designed by Ralph Adams Cram and dedicated in 1926, the Gothic Chapel was built to be filled with light. Nine master glassmakers from America and Europe created the 36 stained-glass windows and 12 clear-glass windows.

Gothic rose windows emulate a flower, with narrow, pointed lancets radiating out like petals.

The Kindness window, located on the east side of the Chapel, features beautiful depictions of compassion: Saint Martin cutting his cloak in half to give to a beggar; Saint Vincent de Paul cradling a child; Saint Francis of Assisi preaching to animals; and the Good Samaritan assisting a traveler.

As part of the ongoing Chapel window restoration project, the Kindness window was fully restored in October 2019.

PRO TIPS: How to Scan and Upload your Artwork

- 1 **Download Google PhotoScan:** Google PhotoScan is a free mobile app for IOS and Android that lets you digitize physical photos using your phone's camera. It uses computational photography to eliminate glare and crop edges perfectly.
- 2 **Prepare:** Place your printed photo on a flat, well-lit surface with a contrasting background.
- 3 **Open the App:** Launch PhotoScan and position your printed photo inside the viewfinder frame.
- 4 **Take the initial shot:** Tap the shutter button once to take the first picture.
- 5 **Follow the dots:** Four white dots will appear on the screen. Slowly move your phone so the center circle hovers over each dot until it turns blue.
- 6 **Save:** The app will automatically stitch the images together, remove glare, crop the borders, and save the perfect digital copy to your device.
