District Goals

- Increase student achievement in all content areas and across all subgroups by 5% of potential growth on state assessments.
- Create a healthy and positive school culture and climate that uses collaborative problem-solving approaches to address conflict in schools and meets the needs of the whole child as measured by school climate ratings.
- Increase student achievement by 5% of potential growth for SWD while closing the achievement gap with other subgroups.
- Increase teacher retention in an effort to improve teacher effectiveness and to increase potential leader pool.

Louisville Academy Goals

- Improve scores on the GA Milestones Assessments in all content areas by 5% (or more) of potential growth in the ranges of proficient and distinguished.
- Louisville Academy will improve overall positive responses on the annual School Climate Survey by 5% for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Improve performance of SPED students on the GA Milestones Assessments by 5% (or more) of potential growth for the ranges of proficient and distinguished.

Carver Elem Goals

- Improve instructional quality, student engagement, and teacher effectiveness through effective leadership, resulting in 90% of teachers identified as Tier 1 teachers by May 2027.
- By May 2027, CES will implement the school-wide instructional framework with fidelity, increasing the percentage of students meeting grade-level expectations in Reading/ELA and Math by 15%.
- By May 2027, increase teacher capacity through tiered support and collaborative PLCs, resulting in 90% of teachers implementing evidence-based instructional practices.

Wrens Elem Goals

- We will increase student achievement in ELA and across sub-groups by 5% potential growth on state assessments.
- We will increase student achievement in Math and across sub-groups by 5% potential growth on state assessments.
- Increase the overall positive responses on the annual School Climate Survey by 5%.
- 100 % of our staff will participate in the professional development opportunities as outlined in GaLEADS to promote teacher efficacy and effectiveness.

JCMS Goals

- SPED achievement goals will grow 5% from Fall to Spring admin of iReady Diagnostic and Lexile data in ELA/Math.
- Increase the percentage of students scoring at proficient and exemplary in ELA/Math by 5% of potential growth.
- Increase the percentage of students scoring proficient and exemplary in 8th grade Science by 5% of potential growth.
- 90% of teachers will incorporate Parent Pro Tech lessons during advisement by May 2027.

JCHS Goals

- Teachers will implement Clarity for Learning in order to improve student engagement by 15%, as measured by Engagement Walks and Visible Learning Walks.
- JCHS will improve overall positive responses on the annual School Climate Survey by 5% for the 2026-2027 school year.
- Teachers will implement research-based instructional strategies in order to improve student achievement by 5%, as measured by EOCs and final exams.
