Tuition, Payment Info & Refund Policy (2027 Session)

This Payment & Refund Policy applies to all students enrolled in Canadian College Italy Summer Academy. By confirming enrollment, the parent or legal guardian confirms acceptance of this policy and CCI's applicable enrollment requirements.

1. Tuition rates

All tuition rates are per student and stated in Canadian dollars.

Enrolment rate	Tuition (Canadian)	Tuition (International)	Availability
Returning-family	\$6,250	€4,000	2026 Summer Academy families; reply by 23 August 2026. No new application.
Priority	\$6,550	€4,300	24 August-31 October 2026, or until priority places are filled.
Regular	\$7,050	€4,650	1 November 2026-28 February 2027.
Late	\$7,450	€4,950	From 1 March 2027, space permitting.

Returning families: No new application is required. Reply by August 23, 2026; once CCI confirms re-enrolment, the deposit is due within seven calendar days.

2. Payment schedule

Deposit - A non-refundable deposit of \$1,500 CAD or €1,000 EUR is due within seven calendar days of CCI's confirmation of enrolment. The deposit is credited toward tuition. A student's place and applicable tuition rate are secured only when the deposit has been received.

Second payment - A second payment of \$2,000 CAD or €1,250 EUR is due by January 15, 2027.

Final payment - The remaining balance by 15 March 2027.

If a student enrolls after one of these dates, any amount already due must be paid with the deposit. Missed payments may result in the place being released.

Students enrolling after January 15 must pay the deposit and second payment together. Students enrolling after March 15 must pay the full tuition amount within seven calendar days of confirmation.

If a payment is missed, CCI will contact the family in writing. If payment is not received or alternative arrangements have not been approved within seven calendar days, CCI may release the student's place. Any amounts already paid will be handled according to the Summer Academy 2027 Payment & Refund Policy.

3. How to pay

Canadian-dollar payments - E-transfer to **payments@canadiancollegeitaly.com**. Please include the student's full name and 'Summer 2027' in the message.

International payments - Families outside Canada will normally receive an invoice in euros with CCI's banking instructions.

Credit cards - Available upon request. Any processing fee will be clearly shown before payment.

4. Withdrawals and refunds

A parent or legal guardian must send a written notice of withdrawal to the admissions contact shown in the student's confirmation or invoice. The date CCI receives the written notice determines the refund.

Written withdrawal received	Refund
On or before 15 March 2027	75% of tuition paid above the deposit
16 March-1 May 2027	50% of tuition paid above the deposit
2 May 2027 or later	No refund

How refunds are calculated - The percentages above apply only to tuition payments received above the non-refundable \$1,500 (€1,000 EUR) deposit.

Before 2 May - Any future tuition installments not yet due are cancelled once the withdrawal is processed.

From 2 May - The full tuition remains payable and no refund is available.

5. Important information

Personal withdrawals - The refund schedule applies to withdrawals for any reason, including illness, injury, family circumstances, homesickness, or changes in travel plans.

After the program begins - No refund is provided for late arrival, absences, missed activities, voluntary early departure, or dismissal for a breach of CCI's Code of Conduct or safety requirements.

Program changes - CCI may make reasonable changes to courses, teachers, activities, excursions, accommodation, transportation, or schedules. Where possible, a suitable alternative will be provided. These changes do not constitute cancellation of the program.

If CCI cancels the program - CCI will refund all tuition and deposits paid directly to CCI. CCI cannot reimburse airfare, insurance, bank charges, or other third-party costs.

Travel insurance - Families are strongly encouraged to purchase travel medical and trip cancellation/interruption insurance covering the full program cost and airfare.

6. What tuition covers

Tuition covers the academic program, room and board, scheduled meals, residence supervision, published activities and excursions, program transportation, and airport transfers during CCI's designated service windows, as described in the final 2027 program materials.

Airfare, insurance, personal and medical expenses, passports or other required travel documents, and costs caused by travel outside CCI's designated service windows are not included.
