Optimal health is essential for maximum utilization of educational opportunities and should occupy a prominent place within the broad objectives of education. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania mandates that health room nurses administer health screenings annually of all students during the school year and anytime if requested by a parent or staff member. Below are the grades and associated screenings:

All Grades: height, weight, vision

Grades K, 1, 2, 3, 7, 11: hearing

Grades 6 & 7: scoliosis

Referrals are sent home for any possible vision, hearing, or scoliosis concerns.

Parents and guardians may exempt their students from height and weight measurements with a written request. Please contact your school nurse to request an exemption.

If you have questions about our health screenings, please contact your school nurse. Thank you for helping us to keep all our students healthy and safe!
