



Parent / Caregiver Code of Conduct Agreement and Expectations

Beaver Athletics is committed to fostering a positive, respectful, and educational experience for all student-athletes. We value the partnership between coaches, student-athletes, and families. As the parent/caregiver of a Beaver student-athlete, I understand that my actions contribute to that experience and agree to uphold the following expectations throughout the athletic season.

- Playing time is determined by the coaching staff and is based on factors including attendance, effort, attitude, preparation, commitment, and team needs. At the varsity level, playing time is not guaranteed. At the sub-varsity level, all student-athletes will have opportunities to participate, though playing time may not be equal.
- Support my student-athlete's commitment to attend all practices, games, and team activities, and understand that absences or lateness may affect playing time and standing on the team.
 - Communicate any anticipated absences or lateness to the coaching staff and athletic department as early as possible. Except in cases of illness or emergencies, less than 24 hours' notice is not considered acceptable.
- Encourage my student-athlete to take ownership of communicating directly with their coaches whenever appropriate.
- Model integrity, respect, and good sportsmanship toward student-athletes, coaches, officials, opposing teams, and spectators at all times.
- Cheer in a positive and supportive manner and refrain from negative, critical, or inappropriate comments from the sidelines.
- Allow coaches to coach by refraining from coaching or instructing student-athletes from the sidelines.
- Respect the decisions of coaches and officials, understanding that judgment calls are part of athletics and are not subject to discussion during or after contests.
- Wait at least 24 hours following a game or practice before requesting a meeting regarding playing time, strategy, or coaching decisions.
 - Parents/caregivers should first address concerns directly with the coach before contacting the Athletic Director.
- Remain in designated spectator areas and not enter team benches, dugouts, locker rooms, competition areas, or playing surfaces unless directed by school personnel.
- Return all Beaver-issued uniforms, equipment, and gear loaned to student-athletes at the conclusion of the season. Items not returned may result in a replacement fee.

I understand that failure to follow these expectations may result in restricted attendance at athletic events or other consequences deemed appropriate by the Athletic Department.
