UPDATED SAFETY PROCEDURES

These safety procedures exist to help keep the public safe and to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable experience at our stadium.

(Procedures are subject to change for certain events. Visit www.bmtisd.com for more information.)

Metal Detectors

At each entrance gate, there will be walk through and handheld metal detectors similar to those used in most stadiums and arenas. Before you pass through the metal detectors, you will be required to place, in a small basket on the screening table, all bags, hats, phones, cameras and other large metal objects. Upon clearance, you will be admitted into the stadium.

Guests will be encouraged to take prohibited items back to their cars. Items left at the gates are not the responsibility of Beaumont ISD.

Additional Security Measures:

- There will be two single-file lines at each entrance.
- All personal items are subject to a search.
- No backpacks or umbrellas are allowed.
- No outside food or drinks are allowed (i.e. Yeti cups, disposal plastic cups, soft drinks, etc.).
- Weapons – including but not limited to firearms, knives, mace are prohibited.

Portable stadium cushion seats are allowed.

Bag Size Restrictions

- No bags or purses larger than 8.5" x 11" (The size of a standard size piece of paper) will be allowed into the stadium. Bags will be measured at the gate and must fit within this requirement.
- Bags that are a medical necessity are only permitted when the contents will not fit within an 8.5"x11" bag.
- All bags, regardless of size or type are subject to a search.

The stadium and ticket booths will open at 5:30pm. Please arrive early to allow yourself time to go through security checkpoints. Ambassadors will be stationed at each gate to communicate procedures to fans prior to entry, and fan feedback will be monitored to make needed adjustments. Ensuring public safety is our top priority.

ATTENTION ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL PARENTS:

Student IDs Required: All elementary, middle, and high school students, as well as their student guests, must present a valid student ID at the admission gates. This includes students from non-district, private, and charter schools. **Students without an ID will not be permitted entry.**

Parent/Guardian Accompaniment: Middle and elementary school students must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to attend sporting events. Siblings in high school do not qualify as guardians. **Unaccompanied middle or elementary students will not be allowed entry.**

Parents, in order to ensure the safety of all students, elementary and middle school students attending athletic events at the BISD Memorial Stadium must be accompanied by a parent or guardian responsible for the students during the athletic event. Students in elementary and middle school can no longer be dropped off at the stadium for an athletic event without a parent or guardian. We ask that you support our efforts to ensure that all students are safe.
