Meadowlawn Parents & Guardians,

Our goal at Meadowlawn Middle School is to provide quality educational experiences in an inclusive environment that focuses on educating our scholars from the time they enter school until they are dismissed.

Wireless Communication Devices:

Middle School scholars must keep wireless communication devices (including wearable recording devices) in the off position and in their backpack/bag/purse throughout the instructional school day and while participating in a school-sponsored activity on or off campus. Electronic devices are not to be visible during the school day. Scholars are permitted to use their wireless communication devices/headphones before and after the instructional school day (prior to 9:20 AM and after 4:10 PM).

Smartwatches:

All the rules applicable to wireless communication devices apply to smartwatches; however, a scholar may wear a smartwatch only in silent mode during the instructional day so there is not to be disruption to the classroom. A smartwatch may not be worn during district and state assessments.

Responsibility/Liability:

Any scholar who chooses to bring a wireless communication device to school shall do so at their own risk and shall be personally responsible for the security of their wireless communication device(s). School Board staff are not responsible for preventing theft, loss, damage, or vandalism to wireless devices brought onto school property, or left on school-sponsored transportation, including any wireless communication device(s) confiscated due to inappropriate use.

We understand there are times it's necessary to contact your scholar or your scholar to contact you; if so, reach out to the appropriate grade-level office, we will relay messages to your scholar:

If there are incidents of noncompliance, scholars will receive consequences:

1st Offense: Minor Infraction, Guardian Contact, Device Confiscated (returned to scholar end of day)

2nd – 3rd Offense: Minor Infraction, Guardian Contact, Guardian Pick-Up Device

Subsequent Offenses: Major Referral, Guardian Pick-Up Device, 1 Day ABS

*Consequences reset at the beginning of each quarter.

Front office hours are 9:10 A.M. – 4:40 P.M.; devices must be picked up between these hours. We appreciate your support to ensure policy compliance and creating the best learning environment for your scholar.
