

## NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Greene County Board of Education has tentatively adopted a 2026 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 8.32%. Three hearings are required for public discussion.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings to be held at the Greene County Board of Education Office Building at 101 East Third Street, Greensboro, GA 30642 on **August 13, 2026 at 6:00 pm**. Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at the Greene County Board of Education Office Building, Greensboro, GA 30642, on **August 17, 2026 at 9:00 am and August 20, 2026 at 5:00 pm**.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 9.847 mills, an increase of 0.756 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 9.091 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a market value of \$775,000 is approximately \$232.85 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$475,000 is approximately \$143.64.
