



2026-2027 Student Parking Information

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2027,

We hope this letter finds you well and enjoying the summer months! We are looking forward to welcoming you back in September for what we anticipate will be an exciting **Senior Year!**

As Seniors, you are offered **two parking options** if you plan to drive to school. Below you will find links to access the Student Parking Application, Guidelines, and Procedures for obtaining your parking spot and tag, regardless of the option you choose. **PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION IN ITS ENTIRETY and complete ALL necessary steps.**

As a general reminder, parking at LTHS is a **senior privilege**. Juniors will be issued parking permits on a first-come, first-served basis. **ALL STUDENTS that will be driving to school MUST complete one of these two options or they will not be permitted to park on campus.**

Please note that student drivers may lose driving privileges for violation of school rules and regulations, particularly for excessive absences, tardiness, cutting, leaving school grounds without parent/guardian permission and signing out in the Attendance Office, continual disciplinary referrals, etc. Students must abide by all school regulations. Parents and students should review the Student/Family Handbook for a full list of guidelines.

Students are advised that in cooperation with the Lacey Township Police Department, students cited for moving violations may lose their parking privileges. Students driving recklessly in the parking lot will also lose their parking privileges. A student who is denied their driving privilege may appeal such a decision to the principal. The decision of the principal is final.

Please review the two available options. Regardless of the option chosen, **all seniors must complete/submit the required forms and documentation** to be eligible for a parking permit.

Option 1: 'Paint - A - Spot' Fundraiser – \$25 for Parking Space and Tag (\$5 additional for a Second or Replacement Tag)

Seniors who wish to paint and personalize their own parking spot must follow the steps outlined in our Paint-a-Spot Guidelines. **This option is only available until August 28, 2026. After this date, see 'Option 2' below.**

 Option 2: General Student Parking Tag – First Parking Tag is Free (\$5 for a Second or Replacement Tag)

Students who do not wish to paint a parking spot may still obtain a general parking tag to park in the east parking lot located by the football field throughout the school year.

Seniors who wish to obtain only a general parking tag must follow the steps outlined in our Student General Parking Guidelines.
