

French IV Language and Culture Syllabus

Course Description/Goals:

French IV expands upon concepts mastered in French III and significantly advances the skills across all four language domains: listening, speaking, reading, and writing, with emphasis on the ability to communicate effectively in spontaneous conversations and formal presentations. A student's proficiency level is developed through sophisticated, age-appropriate and culturally authentic resources to enable students to participate in extended dialogues about complex topics, analyze and defend opinions or positions using advanced vocabulary and idiomatic expressions, through detailed statements and compound-complex sentences in written and oral responses. This accelerated course is enhanced with a rich variety of print, digital, audio, and audiovisual materials, including authentic literary texts and media, to support advanced language development. Students in French IV Honors are expected to reach an intermediate mid to intermediate high level of language proficiency at completion of study.
