

Spanish II (Honors) Syllabus

Course Description/Goals:

Spanish II Honors exceeds the traditional Spanish II level course by including a more in-depth study of the language, requiring students to perform at the higher level. A focus on student's oral proficiency level is developed using culturally authentic resources which support students to participate in significantly longer dialogues while expressing and supporting their opinions or preferences using expanded vocabulary, through short statements and complex sentences in written and oral responses. Authentic materials will be read, and longer, directed compositions will be written. This course is enhanced with a variety of print, digital, audio, and audiovisual materials to support language development. Students in Spanish II Honors are expected to reach a *novice high* to *intermediate low* level of language proficiency at completion of study.
